HEADS UP! COLLEEN IS GOING BALD!

This is Colleen Simon - I'm excited for my 4th year fighting pediatric cancers, raising money and shaving my head at the "Brave The Shave" event in Sioux Falls on July 9th! Money raised goes to the St. Baldrick's Foundation, a volunteer and donor powered charity committed to supporting the most promising research to find cures for childhood cancers and give survivors long and healthy lives. I have raised funds without shaving one time, but losing my hair is an important way I can honor my daughter, Alison, and her personal battle with cancer. It's pretty common for cancer warriors to lose their hair, but it was different in Alison's case. (Photo of our friend, Ricky

Reuwsaat & Alison, Dec. 2015) Her type of cancer, stage 4 Burkitt lymphoma and leukemia, is the most aggressive form of lymphoma known. If left untreated, a patient with Burkitt's could die within two weeks. So, her chemotherapy doses had to be very strong. Alison not

only lost all the hair on her head, her eyebrows and eyelashes, but also her internal hair, like in her sinuses, causing her nose to run constantly. When treatment ended, it took such a long time for her hair, inside and out, to grow back. She has had No Evidence of Disease (NED) for 6 years now! The least I can do to honor Alison and all children battling cancer is to be temporarily bald.
