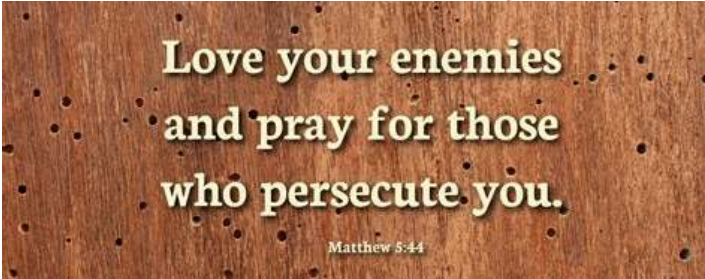

### ASH WEDNESDAY LITURGY SCHEDULE

Mass and ashes in Sacred Heart Church will be at 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., and in St. Pius X Church at 5:15 p.m. on Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023. Instead of having YFF mission sessions in either parish, we will sit together as a group at the evening Masses in each parish. There will be confessions available after all Ash Wednesday Masses.

#### Lent Regulations for Catholics:

All Fridays throughout the year, especially during Lent, are penitential days. **Abstinence:** All who have reached their 14th birthday are to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. **Fasting:** All those who are 18 or older, until their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is one full meal and two lesser meals without eating between meals.



### PROJECTOR & LIVESTREAM VIDEO TRAINING

We will be having training for running the projector and livestream video in the Sacred Heart Church sacristy for all present and new volunteers after the 7:00 p.m. Ash Wednesday Mass (about 7:50 p.m.). Our greatest need is to have a livestream video operator available for funerals during school hours.
