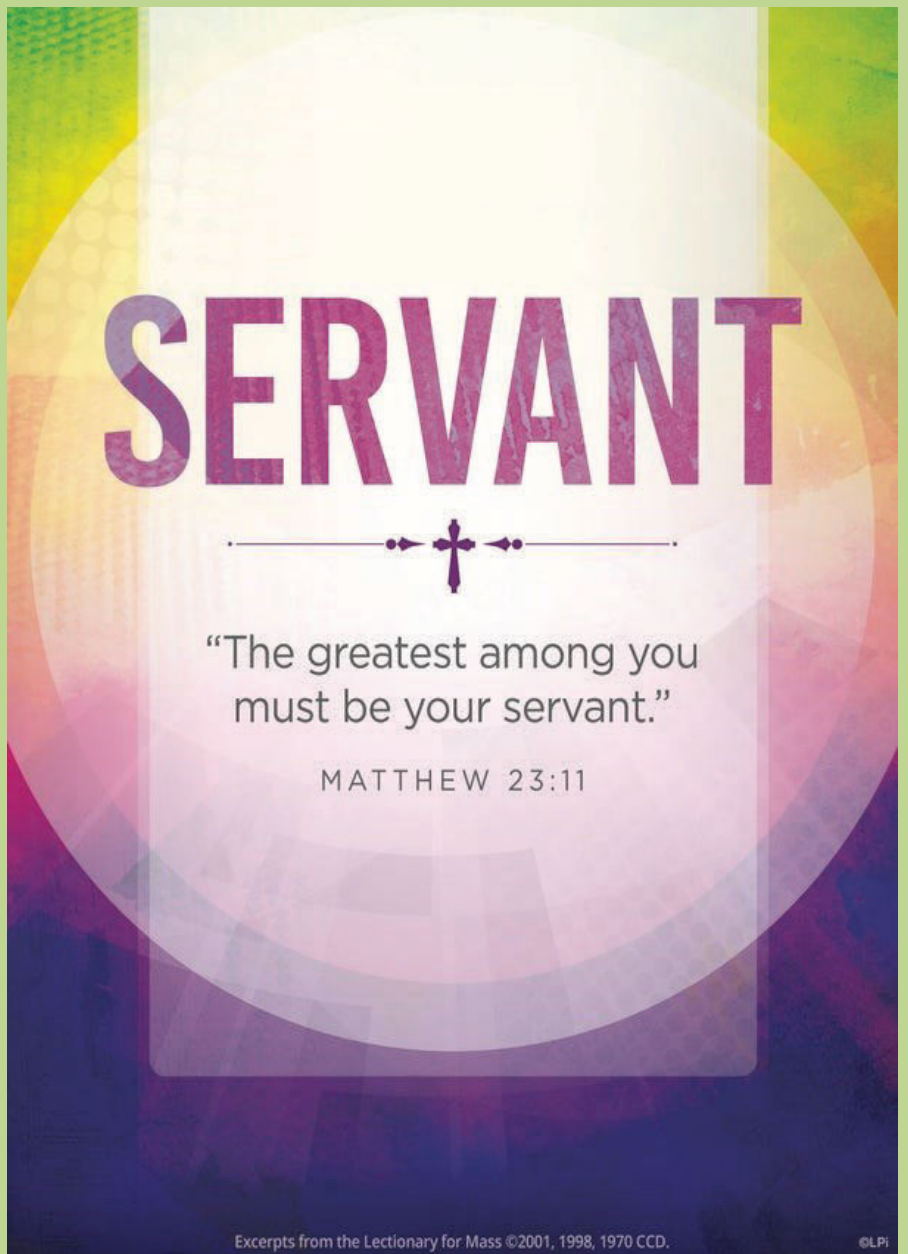

The Set Ablaze restructuring for the diocese continues. The next step is to produce a survey with questions about worship, service, community, and evangelization. Where are we today? Where do we want to be in the future? How to get there? How will we know if we did get there? The Pastorate Leadership Team will begin to develop the survey soon via emails. Last week there were some members who attended a training on producing surveys.

In the interim it is important that everyone prays for the guidance of the Holy Spirit. As this last week many of us remembered those who have gone before us, so may we learn from them how they prepared for the future of church life. Church is more than bricks and mortar if the faith is to continue. Our time of worship needs to be accompanied by service. Catholic teaching has always promulgated that faith requires good works and good works must be done with faith. The two entities always go together and never separated. The result of faith and work is the development of community.

The name we give community is church or people of faith and works. But faith and work do not grow without evangelization and discipleship. Set Ablaze will be a medium for bringing everything together and build for a stronger Catholic presence in our diocese. Again, it all begins with prayer which our ancestors incorporated into the routines of daily life. May we learn for them as we plan.

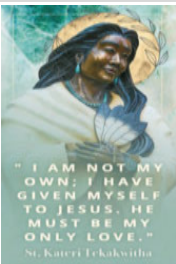

Saints are an important part of our Catholic identity. They are prime examples of how to live holy lives. They were not perfect. They made mistakes just like us, but they ultimately turned to God for the graces to one day be with him in Heaven.

We teach the students that saints are people that are proven to be in Heaven with God. They learn about the process of obtaining sainthood. They learn about the miracles done through the intercession of these saints.

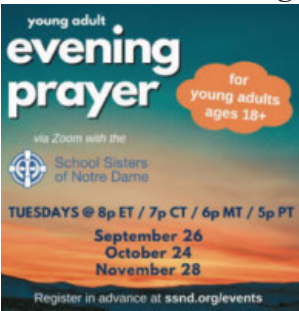
