

Fr. Joe's Jottings

Many years ago, a sign company used a slogan in their advertising, "a business with no sign is a sign of no business." Although parishes are not businesses, it is necessary for them to have signs. Most Catholic Church signs identify the patron saint of the community and give pertinent information concerning the times of the Holy Mass.

When one drives into Onida, there a big bold sign that seizes ones' attention. Therefore, it is very effective in conveying the message the Mass time at St. Pius X. It is simple and modest, but very well done. In memory of Winifred and Clara Fox, the costs were covered.

The electronic portion of the sign at St. Anthony in Hoven has ceased to function; therefore the digital portion is being replaced. Many donors have contributed to the expenses. The beautiful building commands attention from miles away on the prairies. When people park in front of the church the new parts of the sign will be easily read.

A similar story for Sacred Heart in Gettysburg. The replacement digital board will be noticeable to all traveling on US 212. We can be grateful to many donors for their generosity as well.

On July 13, an act of God destroyed the former sign at SS Peter and Paul. A new sign will be erected closer to Euclid Avenue for anyone traveling on US 83 & 14. With the proposed road construction this sign will be temporary with the permanent installation being completed after the street is finished.

The messaging on the digital boards at each location will be similar for the sake of communicating the events affecting the life of our Pastorate. Therefore, the signs will contain both pastorate and parish information. An example would be the Eucharistic Procession and Rosary on Sunday, August 18 at the South Dakota Capitol Building starting at 1:00 pm. It is hoped that everyone from Holy Rosary Pastorate will either be there in person or at home praying with us at that time.




