

Getting' Real with the Deacon

As you read this I will be with my family on a spiritual journey to Portugal, where my daughter Jennie and I will ride the Camino de Santiago or the "Way of St. James. The Portugal Camino will take us from Porto along the Portugal coast to the Cathedral Santiago St. James where the remains of St. James the Apostol lie in rest. It is a sacred site and only Rome and Jerusalem receive more pilgrims each year.

Tradition says that Saint James was sent by Peter to the Roman Province of Spain to preach the Gospel to the Celtic people. The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Saint James in Spain on the bank of the Ebro River. This is the first Marian apparition, known as "Our Lady of the Pillar." St. James returned to Judaea where he was beheaded by Herod Agrippa in 44 AD. According to tradition the physical remains of Saint James were transferred from Jerusalem to northern Spain where the relics were carried to Compostela for burial. Following third century Roman persecutions in Spain, his tomb was abandoned but was rediscovered in 814 by a monk who observed strange lights in the night sky. The local bishop confirmed the miracle, and the relics of Saint James were eventually placed in the Cathedral Santiago St. James.

In medieval times, pilgrims sought indulgences at this most holy shrine to St James and believed that they were guaranteed a place in heaven if they completed the pilgrimage. Not that the Church says walking (or biking) the El Camino automatically gets us into heaven, we can receive a Plenary Indulgence for biking the last 200 km (or walking the last 100 km) to the Cathedral of Santiago, praying the Apostle's Creed, the Our Father and a prayer for the intentions of the Pope. As part of the Indulgence, we will also attend Mass at the Cathedral and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Many make the El Camino pilgrimage for spiritual purposes. Even those who aren't Catholic, or even spiritual may walk the Way of St. James because they are on their own journey. We are all nomads here on earth. It is my hope that through prayer and God's love Jennie and I might transform our spiritual lives by walking with our Savior through our journey together.

St. James pray for us.





Within the blue shield is a gold cross with four quadrants, one for each of the four parishes within the Pastorate. In the upper left is the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In the upper right is the keys of St. Peter and the sword of St. Paul. In the lower left is an anchor and a six-pointed star from

and a six-pointed star from the papal coat of arms of St Pius X. The anchor is a reference to Hebrews 6:19, "We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner shrine behind the curtain." The lower right is a lily for the purity of St. Anthony.
