

Father Simon Sez.

With today's gospel reading, we continue our reflection on the Gospel of John chapter 6. In the beginning of this chapter, John tells us Jesus multiplied loaves and fish and walked on water. He demonstrated his power to not only control the physical properties of things but also of his own body. John then presents Jesus' discourse as being the Bread of Life.

In this week's gospel proclamation (Jn 6:51-58), Jesus said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." The Jews asked, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" As believing Christians, we should not doubt that Jesus can give us his flesh to eat and heed his command to receive his flesh and blood so that we might have eternal life.

The Jews took Jesus literally as they should. Jesus said, "For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." He is not speaking of himself by metaphor or analogy or just symbolically but truly. We truly and literally need to eat his flesh and drink his blood. We do this sacramentally under the physical appearance (sign) of bread and wine which symbolizes the actual food we receive – Jesus' flesh and blood. Thus, we come to receive the Real Presence of Jesus, the Bread of Life, in the Eucharist – body, blood, soul, and divinity.

The Lord says in the first reading (Prov 9:1-6), "Come, eat of my food, and drink of the wine I have mixed! Forsake foolishness that you may live; advance in the way of understanding." Pray for a greater understanding by receiving Jesus himself in the Eucharist worthily and a greater realization of his powerful presence by way of the Jericho Wall Eucharistic procession and benedictions this Sunday, August 18th, starting at 1:00 p.m. in front of the SD State Capitol building. May the Eucharist revive us!



Our Holy Rosary Pastorate logo!

The Rosary is in blue, for Mary, and gold, for the Oueen Mother of our Lord Jesus. The Rosary is our defense, protection, and shield. Within the blue shield is a gold cross with four quadrants, one for each of the four parishes within the Pastorate: The Sacred Heart of Jesus in the upper left, the keys of St. Peter & the sword of St. Paul in the upper right, an anchor and a six-pointed star from the papal coat of

arms of St Pius X in the lower left (the anchor is a reference to Hebrews 6:19, "We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner shrine behind the curtain"), and a lily for the purity of St. Anthony in the lower right.


