

# Getting' Real with the Deacon

The end of summer often marks a whirlwind of activity; kids heading back to school, adjusting to new routines, wrapping up summer happenings, and a host of other changes. In the midst of this chaos, it's essential to remember the importance of slowing down and taking care of ourselves.

The concept of the Sabbath, a day of rest and sacred time, is deeply rooted in both Jewish and Christian traditions. It serves as a reminder that we are not meant to be constantly striving and working. God, in His wisdom, instituted the Sabbath as a day of spiritual rejuvenation and communion with Him. In our fast-paced world, finding moments of peace and quiet can feel like a luxury. Yet, spiritual renewal often happens in the stillness. Our Catholic tradition emphasizes the importance of rest and reflection as essential elements of a healthy spiritual life.

We are fortunate to have two retreat centers in our Diocese. Broom Tree Retreat Center located near Irene provides facilities and opportunities to experience an awakening to God's continual call for conversion and to deepen our response to it. A wide range of retreats are offered including Men's and Women's Silent Retreats, Couples Retreats, Healing Retreats, Day of Recollection Retreats or Individual Directed Retreats. Abbey of the Hills is an inn and retreat center located among the lakes and prairie hills of northeastern South Dakota near Marvin. The Abbey hosts overnight guests, retreats, reunions and events that reflect the peace sustained by Benedictine monks for more than 60 years. Events include a Men's Silent Ignatian Retreat, a Women's Healing Retreat, 12 Step Retreats, and Day of Recollection Retreats. Fr. Joe, Fr. Simon, and I will be taking our own spiritual break next month as we attend Clergy Days in Oacoma. Clergy Days is an annual event where priests and deacons gather for education, reflection, and fellowship. It is an event we look forward to. Resting doesn't mean being idle or unproductive. Rather, it involves a conscious decision to step away from the demands of daily life and turn our attention inward. In this stillness, we can connect more deeply with God. Through prayer, meditation, and contemplation, we can experience His peace, love, and guidance.



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary! It is her birthday! Birthdays are special. They are a time of reflection. We as Kids of Christ, look to Mary as our example and reflect on our lives. At St. Joseph Catholic School time is taken throughout the day for daily reflection. A time for the students to talk to God and think about their day.

There is prayer and reflection time in the morning as they begin their day in class. The students take this time to consider how their day has started. They think about what they can do to make it better for themselves and others. Each classroom does it a bit differently. Some classes take this time quietly to themselves, other classrooms gather as a group to pray aloud together. It is a wonderful way to start the day.

Another way the students and staff reflect throughout the day is doing the Angelus Prayer at noon. The Angelus was originally started by the laity as a form of prayer where they would stop what they were doing at 6am, noon, and 6pm when the church bells would ring. So when our church bells ring, our students pray the Angelus.

Finally our students use The Ignatian Examen to meditate on their day. In the prayer, the students are conscious of God's presence. They give thanks for their day while paying attention to their feelings. The students then focus on one thing that may have happened and pray about it.

Reflection can take time, but it only benefits us. We can learn from Mary as she celebrates her birthday how important it is to be patient and take the time to reflect. It will only make us better!


