## Father Simon Sez

The new school year has begun along with Youth Faith Formation (YFF). This is the traditional time to offer Adult Faith Formation (AFF) as well, starting from wherever individual adults find themselves in their spiritual lives. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) has been providing this opportunity for adults in various stages of their faith journeys for many decades.

Every individual has their own unique faith journey. We all have a responsibility to fully engage in our own ongoing process. Since there is a structured, ordered process to this instead of a one-time ritual, the name of this process has been changed from using the word "Rite" to using the term "Order" which is a more faithful translation of the original Latin as well. We now call it the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA). This is not just a series of rituals for full Christian Initiation in the Church, but also stages of this ongoing journey using rituals to mark milestones and provide for progression through the next stage.

All adults, Christians or not, have the opportunity to seek the fullness of Christian initiation and faith in the Catholic Church. Adult Catholics have the opportunity to learn more about their faith and receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, if needed. This is an opportunity for Catholics to fill in some gaps in their religious education and formation but also to be able to ask questions and put it all together in a way that makes sense to them.

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) will meet weekly on Thursday evenings at 7:00 p.m. starting this Thursday, September 19, 2024, throughout the school year. We will meet physically in the Sacred Heart Church basement in Gettysburg and be available live via Zoom as well as recorded for play back later as a Zoom session or in audio only for your convenience. 


