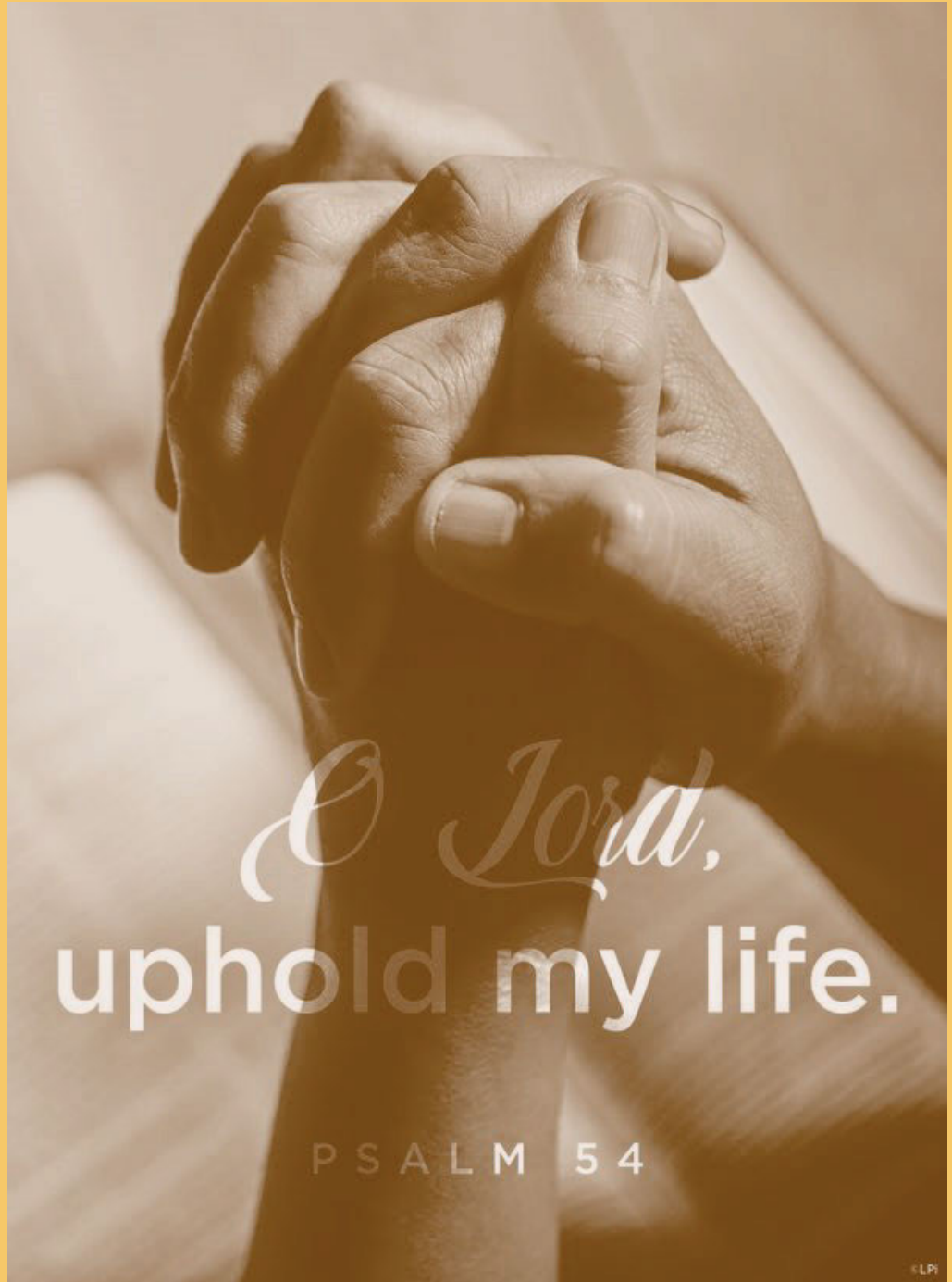

Fr. Joe's Jottings

This weekend we welcome Fr. John Lantsberger to be the celebrant at the Masses in Pierre. He has a sister Elaine Konechne and her husband David who have been members of SS Peter and Paul parish for several years. Fr. Lantsberger was ordained in 1976 along with 6 other men. Those were the days of many ordinations; all have since retired but help out by substituting. Fr. Lantsberger was the parochial vicar at SS Peter and Paul from 1976 to 1978 under the mentorship of Fr. Bob Flannery. He has been in several parishes over the last almost 50 years.

Meanwhile the pastor took a few days off for his mental and physical health by enjoying a “staycation” or just pausing in the rectory. During those days he reflected on the Set Ablaze proposal given to Bishop DeGrood and attempted to summarize it so he could soon print something for everyone in Holy Rosary Pastorate to read. The proposal is already being implemented but will take time. We have a long history which requires all to be patient.

Over the next month Pat Holzhauser, mother of the pastor, will be relocating from Gettysburg to Fort Pierre and then will head south for the winter. After nearly 50 years in the same house, it is quite a process to “right size” for a smaller place. Many items have been accumulated over the years, but some are not as valuable as one thought. With some of the outlets in our pastorate, many small things have been given a chance for a new home. Each of her offspring was given the opportunity to collect anything of sentiment. As a priest who will moving again someday my number of articles was smaller. I have always cherished the Gospel story of “the young man who went away sad, because he had many possessions” so I have reminded myself to embrace the virtue of “detachment.”

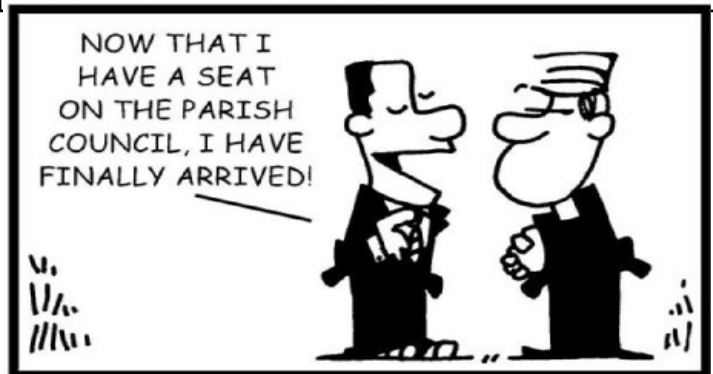
