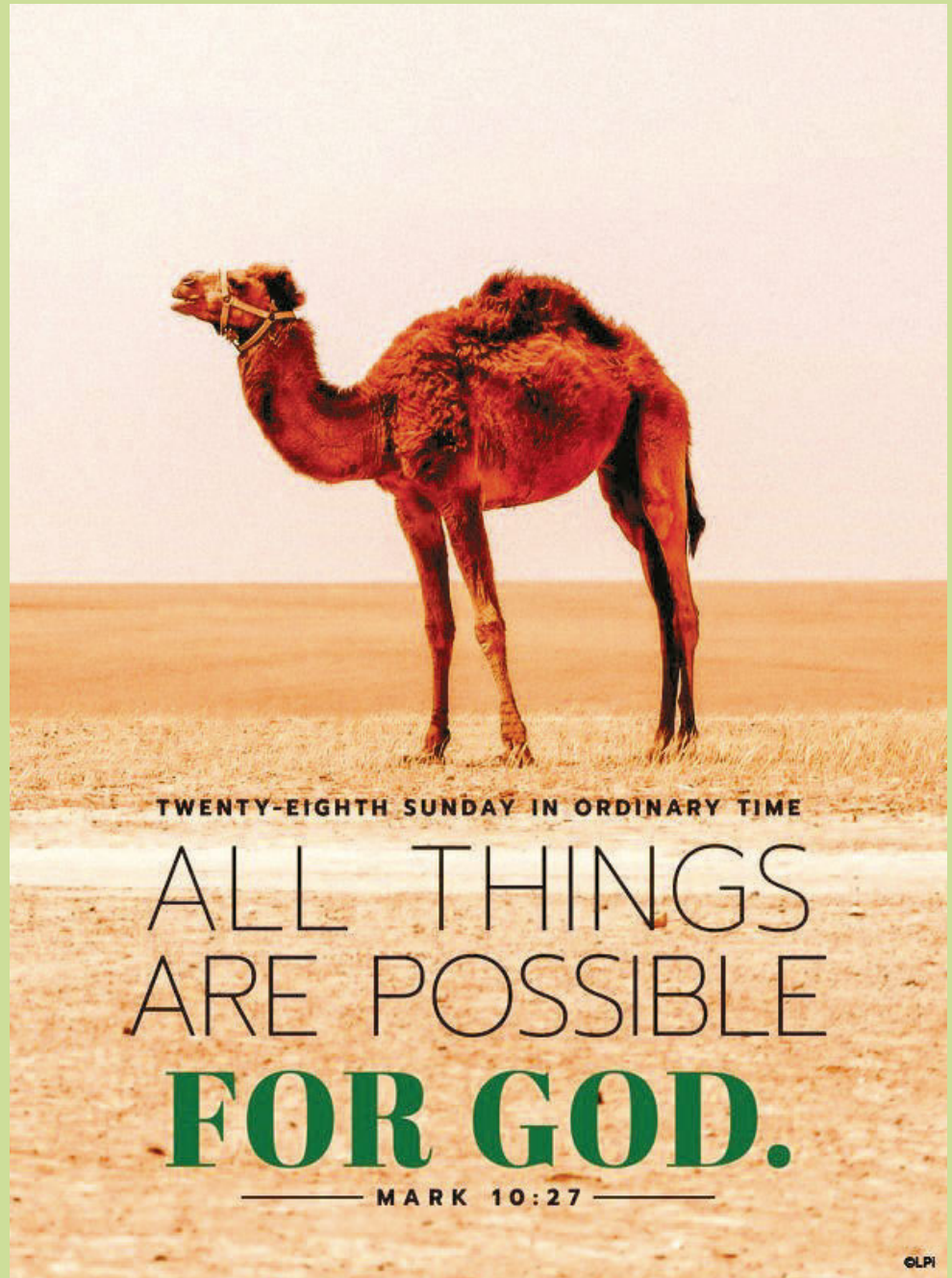

Deacon*

During Clergy Days Father Joe, Father Simon, and I had the privilege of spending a few days in Oacoma along the Missouri River. The Missouri has been a source of inspiration and contemplation for countless individuals throughout history. It has a history of deep cultural significance for Native American tribes who offer us insights into different ways of understanding the divine. Finding God on the shores of the Missouri can be a deeply personal journey and can serve as a catalyst for spiritual growth and understanding. For me, time spent in solitude provided a peaceful setting for prayer and meditation and helped to connect with God in a deeper way.

Reflecting during the week, I was reminded of the group Magdalene we formed just 3 years ago to support women transitioning out of South Dakota Women's Prison (SDWP). When Magdalene began there was an immediate need for feminine products, so a community drive was held and enough supplies collected to get started. Magdalene also reached out to those who might be interested in making drawstring bags for the ladies so they would have something to carry items in when they leave. The response was overwhelming. In three years over 1,350 bags have been made and shared. Thank you so much for supporting women during this transitional time in their lives.

We have reached a point where more bags are needed. If anyone or possibly a youth group would be interested in helping make drawstring shoulder bags for Magdalene, we have a simple pattern that can be followed. They don't take a lot of time to make but can mean a lot to those who receive them. Let me know and we can get you the pattern. We are also in need of fabric for making bags. As always, we are open to product donations and to financial support. Donated items can be left in Magdalene boxes found in the church foyers.

On a side note, Magdalene continues to seek funding for housing for ladies who would like to live in our Pastorate. The goal is to provide women in need the opportunity to get their lives back on track. If you would like to assist in this endeavor, we would love to hear from you.

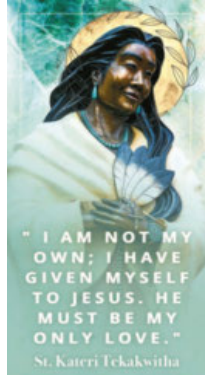

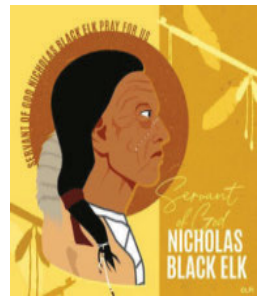
