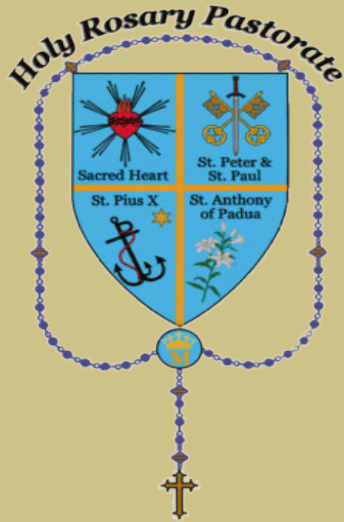

Fr. Simon Sez

Our readings for this Sunday focus on the end times. The Catholic approach is to always be steady, vigilant, and prepared for death which is our own “end time.” The Gospel of Luke 21:36 says, “Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to stand before the Son of Man.” Jesus Christ, the Son of Man, is in charge of the Last Judgment. Nobody can know absolutely that they are prepared for death, and we cannot assume that anyone capable of personal sin is in heaven after death.

The most important help which Jesus provides us through his Church in preparation for death is Last Rites. The Last Rites are not just the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. It includes the Sacrament of Penance with the Apostolic Pardon, the Sacrament of Confirmation (if needed), and viaticum (communion for the final faith journey). If a Catholic loved one is dying, Catholics should make sure a priest knows the person is in danger of death so that he knows he can give the person Last Rites (confirm that the Apostolic Pardon was included). When a person receives the Apostolic Pardon, the priest by the authority of the Apostolic See grants “a full pardon and the remission of all sins” (assuming the person is sorry for their sins). Also, he releases the person “from all punishments in this life and in the life to come.” This means no purgatory due to sins up until that moment! (Jesus gave this authority to Peter alone in Mt 16:19 and his successors, the popes.) The Sacrament of Penance and the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick do not include the releasing of punishment due to sin.

Of course, we need to live every day with faithful vigilance, but when we are at our own “end time,” we need to take advantage of the Last Rites for our final preparation. Please be sure to request the Last Rites, especially the Apostolic Pardon, for your dying loved ones who are Catholic and be sure people who care for you know to ask for this on your behalf. May Jesus find us among His elect with our names written in the Book of Life!

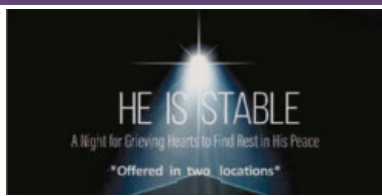
