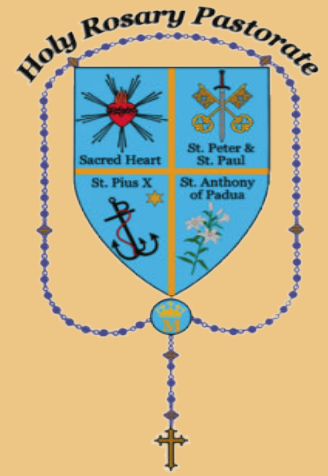

Fr. Joe's Jottings

As we move from fall sports to winter sports at our local high schools, we are at the end of the liturgical year. Therefore the Sunday is called, "Christ the King Sunday." King is somewhat obscure for those of us living in a republic using democracy as guidance. In history, Kings and Queens along with the whole royal family, enjoyed some entitlements. People gave respect and honor because those positions demanded it. In present times there are fewer kings but they still are people of authoritative leadership. In the United States, independence and freedom are of high value so we promulgate cooperation and collaboration.

When the church speaks of Jesus as King, it is not dictatorial, but because He is second person of God. God is almighty, all-powerful and all knowing. Therefore God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit possess all these attributes. 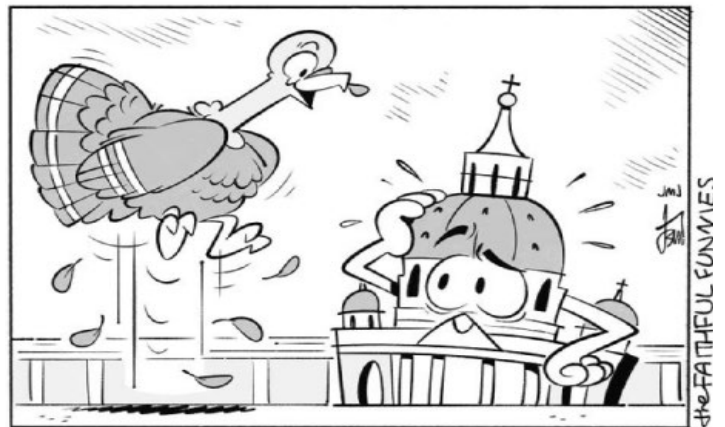

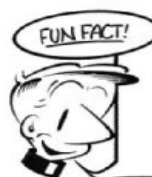
