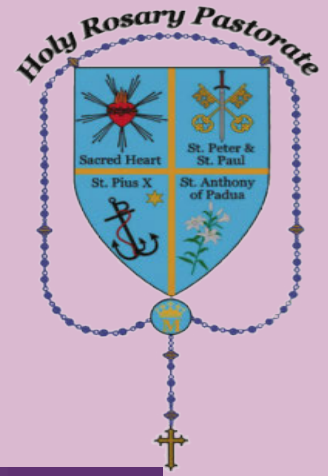

Fr. Joe's Jottings

Happy New Year as we begin the liturgical year this weekend with the First Sunday of Advent. In addition to the usual baptism class for parents, there is a group of young people at SS Peter and Paul that are receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time in their lives. During the Advent season we focus on preparing for the celebration of the Incarnation. Commonly called the birth of Jesus Christ, it is about the Word becoming flesh. God the Father sent His Son to identify with us and lead by physical example how to be fully human. When we don't live in obedience of the plan the Father has for us, it is called sin.

During Advent, we also preparing for the final coming of Christ when He comes to judge the living and dead. Throughout November we prayed to the Saints to intercede for our intentions and for the souls of purgatory to be liberated on Judgment Day. This month is also a time for each of us to prepare for that last day for ourselves. Everyone will want to be in the state of grace when we stand before the throne of God. Therefore, everyone needs to experience the holiness of a good confession of sin so that we may fittingly receive the absolution and forgiveness that Jesus speaks of in Matthew's gospel. A schedule will be mailed to every household in the pastorate during the next 30 days.

One of the aspirations in our Set Ablaze document is that the Sacrament of Reconciliation would be available on a regular basis. Along with the offering of the opportunity, all three clergy would include in their homilies the need to participate in the sacraments of Eucharist and Penance. Over the next few weeks there will be more emphasis on the importance of these sacraments to prepare for Christmas and the end times. Please pray for those who are hearing that they have been forgiven from God and His holy Church this weekend.

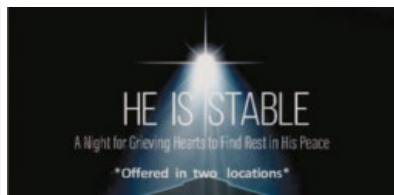

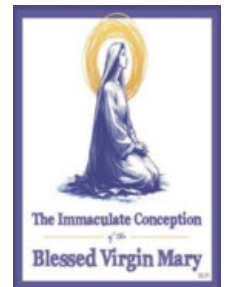
