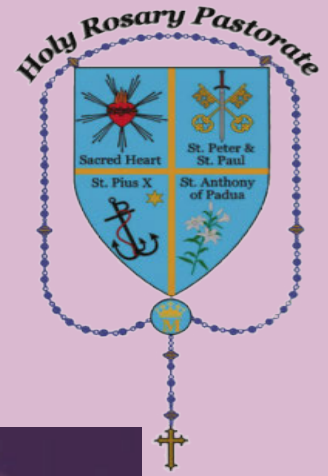

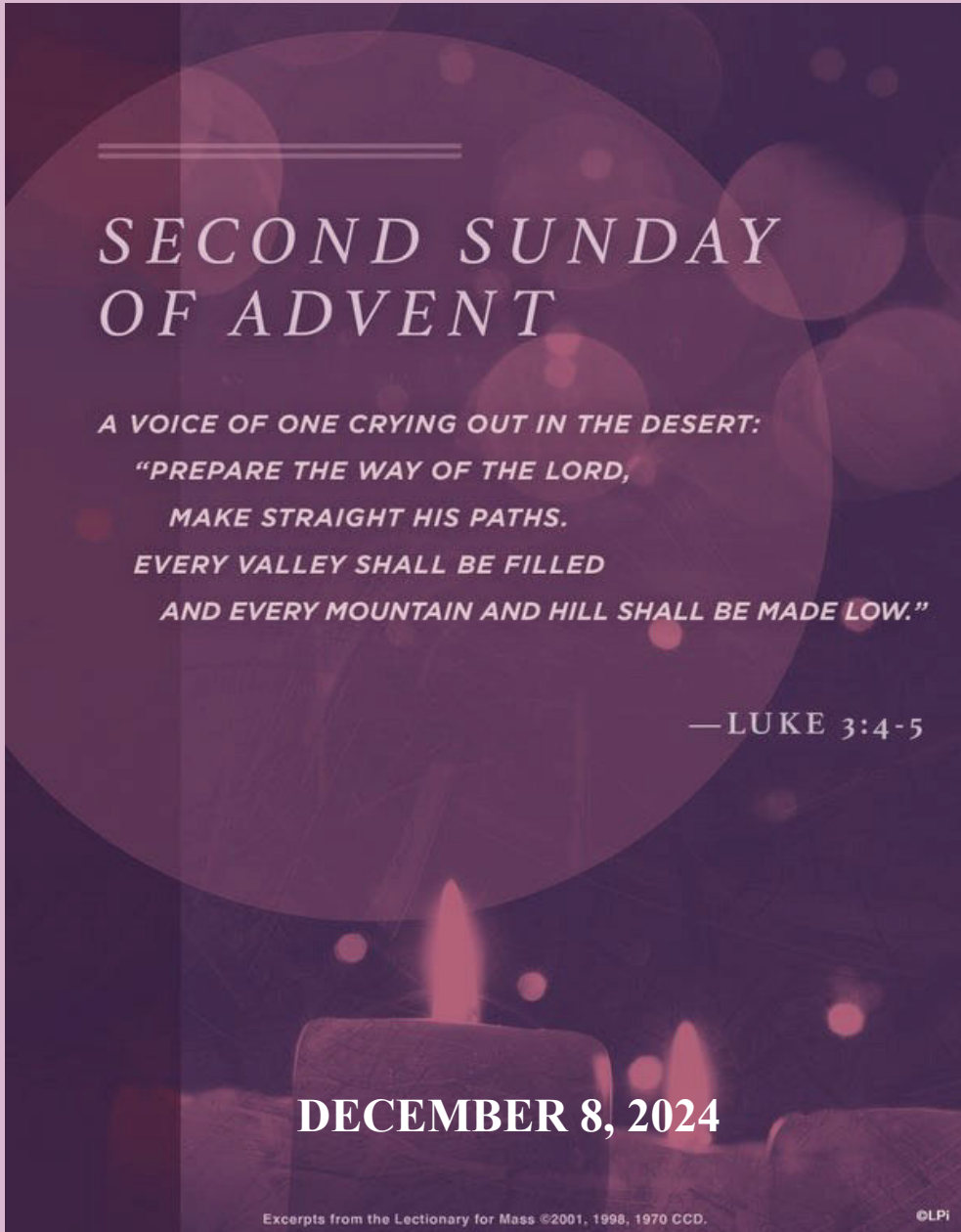

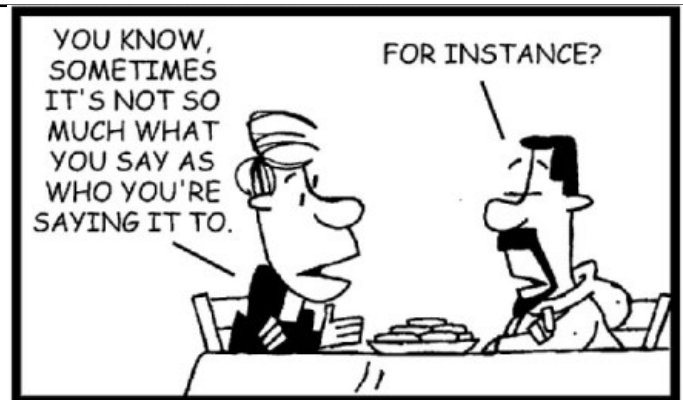
Other solid sites are:

We are celebrating the second Sunday of Advent. We light the second purple candle of peace on our Advent wreath. Do you ever wonder how the tradition of the Advent wreath came to be and what was its meaning?

The Advent wreath has been around for centuries. It is a circle because it symbolizes God’s never ending love for us. As the light of the world, Jesus’ love is infinite. This never ending love is also symbolized by the evergreen trees used to encircle the wreath. They remain green as God’s love remains forever. There are also the four candles. Each one represents what to anticipate for that week. The first Sunday is Hope, the beginning of a new liturgical year. The second Sunday is peace, symbolizing the peace we will be given with the birth of Jesus. The third Sunday is joy, as we anticipate the birth of Jesus. The fourth Sunday is love, Jesus is nearly here!

When your family lights a candle each Sunday, it is nice to do so with a prayer. Here is a prayer from Fr. Henri J.M. Nouwen that you could use:

*Lord Jesus, Master of both light and darkness, send your Holy Spirit upon our preparation for Christmas.*

*We who have so much to do  
seek quiet spaces to hear Your voice each day.*

*We who are anxious over many things  
look forward to your coming among us.*

*We who are blessed in so many ways  
long for the complete joy of Your Kingdom.*

*We whose hearts are heavy  
seek the joy of Your presence.*

*We are Your people, walking in darkness yet seeking the light. To You, we say, “Come, Lord Jesus!”*

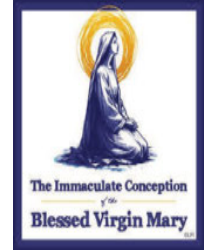

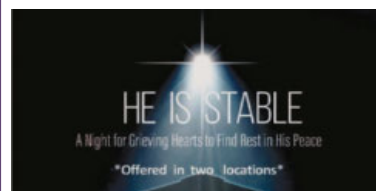
