## Getting' Real with the Deacon

As I thumbed through last week's bulletin in preparation for an article, I was impressed how robust the bulletin is now that we are part of a Pastorate. There is much information to be found in our new eight-page bulletin, including: Schedules, Daily Readings, Prayer Requests, Faith Formation News, Bible Study Announcements, Daily Events, etc. Oh, and one of my favorites, the cartoon "On the Lighter Side". I've always enjoyed reading the comic sections of newspapers and bulletins.

I wanted to touch a little bit on the Mass Intentions. When a priest offers Holy Mass, he has three intentions: *1st* - to offer the Mass reverently and validly in accord with the norms of the Church, *2nd* - to offer the Mass in union with the whole Church and for the good of the whole Church, *3rd* - to offer the Mass for a particular intention, such as the repose of the soul of someone who has died or is ill. A Mass Intention can also be offered for someone celebrating an anniversary, ordination, or a birthday.

We generally make an offering called a stipend when requesting a specific intention. By making this offering and parting with something that is their own, we associate ourselves more intimately with Christ who offers himself in the sacred Host. Keep in mind you are not paying for "graces" from God with a stipend, but for the material things that are involved with celebrating that particular Mass.

Pope Paul VI said, "The Mass is the most perfect form of prayer!" It has immense power and countless miracles and conversions have occurred throughout the centuries by offering Masses for a specific intention or person. The custom is a tradition that goes back to the early days of the Church where inscriptions discovered on tombs in Roman catacombs from the second century mention offering of prayers for the dead during Mass.

Mass intentions are a great treasure of the Church and are priceless. Consider sending the family of a deceased friend or relative a condolence card announcing that Mass will be offered for the soul of the departed. For those experiencing loss in a world of faith, it can provide more comfort than flowers.

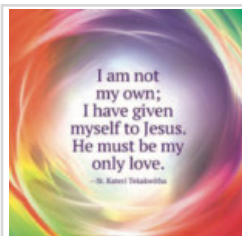

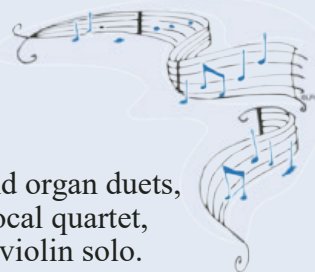
