

Winter high school sports are history. Our young athletes are beginning to focus on spring sports. There are many exercises and training techniques they embrace to improve their performance. Paul speaks of "running the race" as well but as an analogy. The "spiritual" exercises that we embrace are to improve the soul. Throughout the season of Lent we are called to pray, fast and give alms. Lent is the time of the year to get our souls in "shape" after a time of being lackadaisical in our holy routine.

One prayer we can all include in our conditioning is the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This examination of conscience helps us to be honest with ourselves and God. There are many aids all over the internet to assist us by asking questions about sin in our lives. Personally, I have always thought the 10 commandments were the best start. The first three address my relationship with God. Is He the first and most important in my life? Does my family, friends, work, play or myself supersede Him as most important? God and the worship of Him is by far to be first in my decisions and activities.

The last seven commandments call for me to love my neighbor as I do myself. How do I treat others? Do I love or do I judge? Do they know me by my spiritual and corporal works of mercy? Do they see my anger, envy, jealousy or any other capital sin thereby negating my effectiveness to be a Lifelong Catholic Missionary Disciple? How am I setting others ablaze with love for the Eucharist?

As individuals, Lent is a time to develop our sanctity. As a team, Lent is a time to develop our leadership skills.


