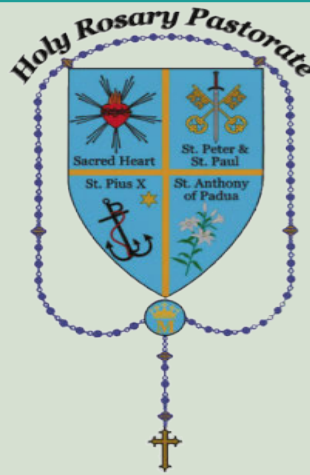


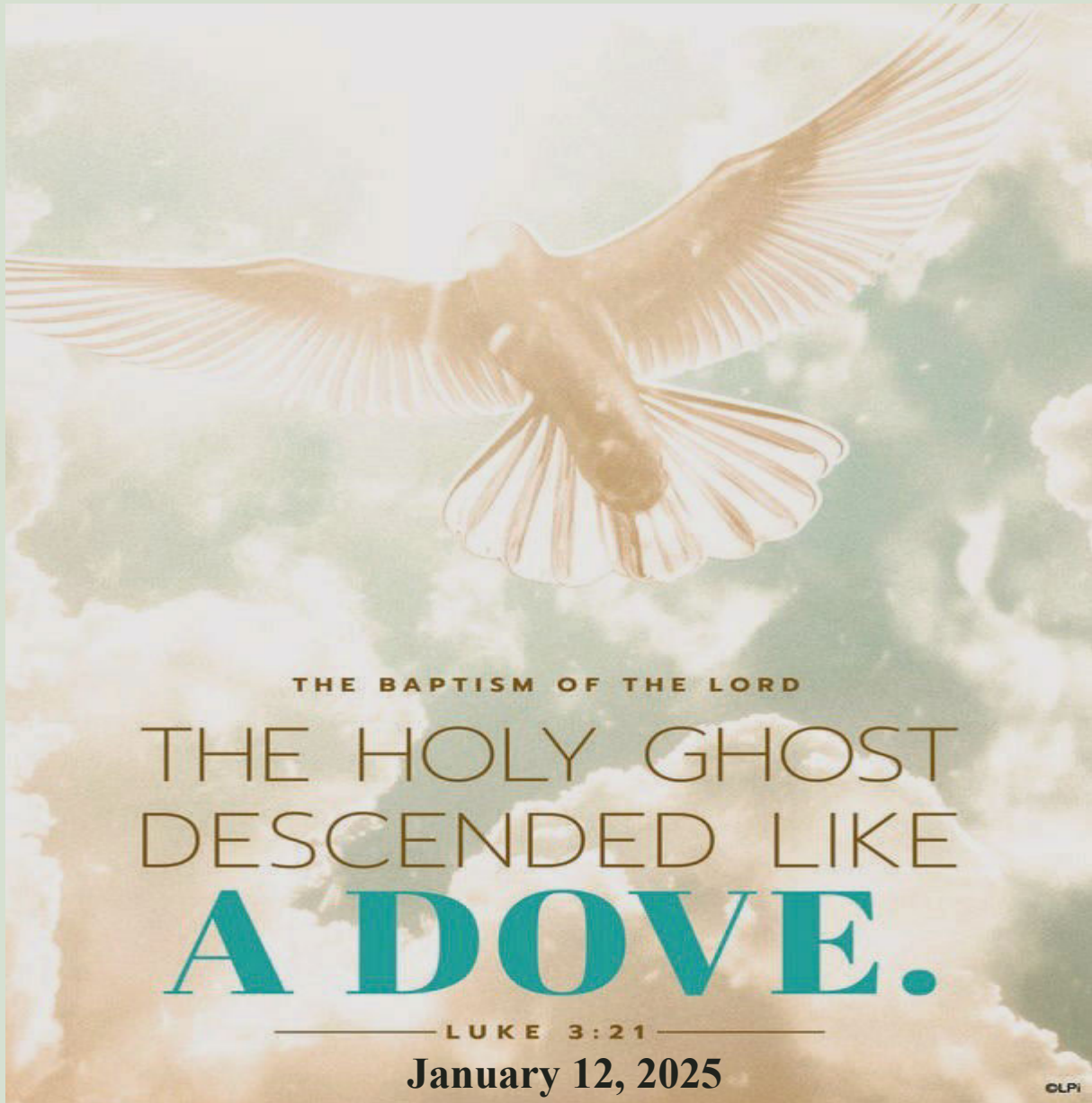

Getting' Real with the Deacon

This Sunday we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, the first public revelation of all Three Persons in the Holy Trinity and the official revelation of Jesus as the Son of God to the world. 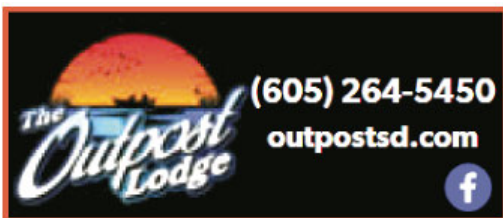
