



# Getting' Real with the Deacon

Last month we shared some Catholic Trivia. Here are the questions and answers:

- ☐ Who is considered the first Pope of the Catholic Church? (St. Peter)
- ☐ What is the largest religious order in the Catholic Church? (The Jesuits)
- ☐ What is the name of the hat worn by bishops and cardinals? (A Mitre is the tall folding cap while the small form-fitting cap is a Zucchetto)
- ☐ Who is the Patron Saint of Happy Marriages? (St. Valentine)

St. Valentine is a nice segue as we prepare to celebrate Valentines Day later this week. For many it's a day filled with heart-shaped boxes, romantic dinners, and expressions of love. But before the commercialization, before the flowers and chocolates, there was St. Valentine. Who was he, and why do we celebrate him? While the details of St. Valentine's life are shrouded in mystery, several legends exist. Most agree that he was a priest or bishop who lived in Rome in the 3rd century AD during a time of Christian persecution. One legend is Emperor Claudius II had outlawed marriages for young soldiers, believing that single men made better fighters. Defying the emperor's decree, Valentine secretly performed marriage ceremonies for the young couples. This act of love and defiance ultimately led to his imprisonment and martyrdom.

Another legend tells of Valentine befriending his jailer's blind daughter. Through his faith and prayers, her sight was miraculously restored. On the day of his execution he wrote her a letter signed, "Your Valentine", a gesture some believe is the origin of the Valentine's Day card. While the historical accuracy of these stories is debated, the core message remains: Valentine was a man of love, courage, and faith. He showed compassion and kindness to those in need, even in the face of his own suffering. On this Valentine's Day, consider these ways to honor St. Valentine:

- ☐ Reflect on the true meaning of love: Beyond romantic love, consider the love we are called to show to everyone, as Christ loved us.
- ☐ Perform a selfless act of love: Reach out to some one in need, offer a helping hand, or simply offer a kind word.
- ☐ Pray for those who are lonely or suffering: Remember those who may not have someone to share Valentine's Day with.
- ☐ Attend Mass and pray for the intercession of St. Valentine: Ask for his guidance in living a life of love and faith.




