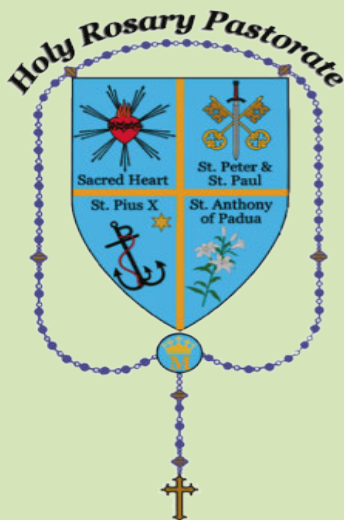

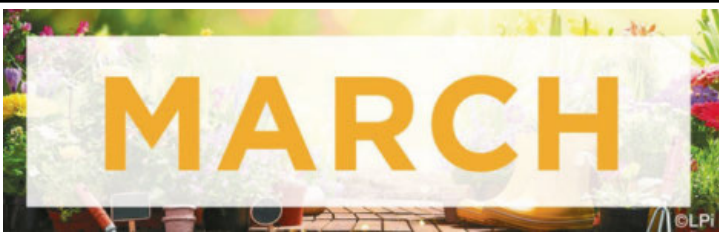

During the month of February, the Parish Finance Councils of each parish met. Although we are all members of the Holy Rosary Pastorate, we are required by church law to maintain the fiscal responsibility of each location. I have highlighted some major discussion points from each meeting.

St. Pius X met and discussed various activities but highlighted the great work of volunteers with the monthly gatherings that involve nourishment. So many are committed to keeping the building clean. The involvement of the Youth Faith Formation students at specific Masses gives hope for the future.

St. Anthony Church will be receiving new windows in the basement as part of the commitment to preserve this beautiful building. Many years ago, Fr. Klapperich sent a letter to everyone in Onaka about the need to fund the maintenance of St. John the Baptist Cemetery. From those humble beginnings that account has grown to over \$100,000.00. When the St. John The Baptist building is demolished and buried in the cemetery it is hoped that people will continue to contribute to that fund.

At the meeting of SS Peter and Paul Parish, it was acknowledged that we continue to be blessed by so many generous contributors to enable us to look forward to the new digital sign and tuckpointing the church in the future.

Sacred Heart Parish is moving forward addressing the normal maintenance items in the parish hall kitchen but additionally planning for replacing the protective glass on the exterior windows. There are always many items to be diligent about, but the care of souls remains the priority.

The pastorate has a new employee, Amy Klein-Greba, who will be the communications director. She will be responsible for the bulletin, social media, the digital signs and any other communication tools that evolve as the Set Ablaze moves forward.

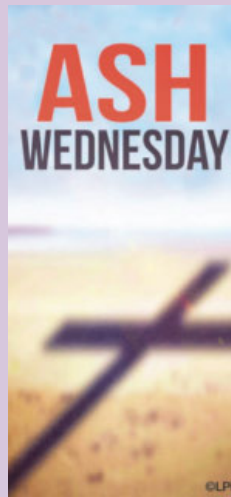

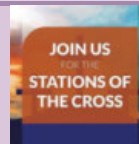
