



At the meeting of SS Peter and Paul Parish, it was acknowledged that we continue to be blessed by so many generous contributors to enable us to look forward to the new digital sign and tuckpointing the church in the future.

Sacred Heart Parish is moving forward addressing the normal maintenance items in the parish hall kitchen but additionally planning for replacing the protective glass on the exterior windows. There are always many items to be diligent about, but the care of souls remains the priority.

The pastorate has a new employee, Amy Klein-Greba, who will be the communications director. She will be responsible for the bulletin, social media, the digital signs and any other communication tools that evolve as the Set Ablaze moves forward. God Bless Us.

Each Friday, we meet as an entire school to learn about a new virtue. The virtue of prayerfulness was the virtue we practiced this week. Prayerfulness is being still, listening, and being willing to talk to God as a friend. Another word to describe prayerfulness would be mindfulness.
