

# Father Simon 'Sez

Have you decided what to do with the grace of Lent to better reject temptations and train yourself to better overcome sin? It might help to compare Satan's temptations of Jesus with Satan's temptation of Eve which led her to convince herself that the forbidden fruit was good for food, a delight to the eyes, and desired to make one wise.

First, Jesus was hungry. Anything edible would have seemed to be good for food. He controlled his hunger instead of letting his hunger control him. If desires of the flesh cause you to sin, fast from whatever it is you are desiring. You can counter the vice of sensuality with the virtue of charity. Do this for love of yourself, because it really is good for you.

Second, the forbidden fruit was a delight to the eyes. It could have looked good to Jesus to have power and glory over all of the kingdoms of the world. This would have made everyone subject to him instead of reject him. In other words, this was a temptation to give in to the vice of vanity. Jesus exercised the virtue of hope in God instead of hope in other people to make him feel delighted.

Third, Eve desired the forbidden fruit, because she pridefully desired to be made wise like God. The devil placed Jesus literally in a position of pride on top of God his Father's house, the temple. Jesus refused to pridefully be eager for power like what God his Father had.

What is your ruling vice? Everyone has one. It is either pride, vanity, or sensuality. If it is pride, humbly exercise your faith by praying and practicing the obedience of faith. If it is vanity, hope in God, not in other people or yourself. If it is sensuality, fast from specific pleasures by practicing works of charity.

You have a specific vice, because you are lacking in its opposing virtue. Choose a specific Lenten practice that will help you develop the opposing virtue to your ruling vice. Using the grace of Lent in this way will help change your heart to become more like the Sacred Heart of Jesus who overcame temptations of the devil.

May you have a holy Lent and therefore, a joyful Easter!

Praying the Stations of the Cross is powerful! The students are exposed to what Jesus went through and how it can relate to our lives even today. The Way of the Cross is the heart of our Christian story.

At SJS, we have been praying the Stations of the Cross together each Friday during Lent. Our students pray them with the school and community members to be closer to Christ.

Stations of the Cross can also be prayed in other ways. It is wonderful to go to a Living Stations of the Cross, where you can watch the Stations unfold as if you are really present. People find a real connection when it is offered visually. If a Living Stations of the Cross is not offered, there are many videos that offer a wonderful rendition of the Stations of the Cross.

Many times, we feel that we need to pray all the Stations of the Cross in one sitting, but that is not true. They can be prayed one by one each day. The classroom or family can focus on one Station each day to really delve into its meaning. Sometimes they can seem overwhelming. It would really help us understand them better if we could sit and focus on one at a time.

Artwork can also add to the understanding of each Station. Drawing it yourself or seeing it through a picture or carving, allows the viewer to imagine what Jesus was going through. The beautiful artwork of Jesus' Passion that adorns the church is a perfect example of how art helps capture our attention.

The school will be praying the Stations of the Cross on March 28, April 4, and April 11 at 2:30pm in the church. Feel free to come pray with us!




