# Fr. Joe's Jottings

There is an email sent each week to all those who have submitted their addresses that is entitled "Against the Current trends" also known as flock notes. There was an interview with Bishop DeGrood on Catholic Views. The question proposed was "is Set Ablaze over" and he explained that this will continue for years to come. The church moves slowly and deliberately.

I am thinking of the changes in Holy Rosary Pastorate. The first change was the adjustment of Mass times and the rotation of priest presiding. The people who help with music have called for some changes from multiple missals in each parish to a uniform one to promote unity within the pastorate. There continues to be more emphasis on community events in each location but also pastorate wide with the Bishop's Fishing Event in June.

It was a goal and will continue to be one every June for people to become involved in that event. It can be as simple as attending the Mass with Bishop DeGrood or purchasing one of the raffle tickets. The committee is open to any suggestions about becoming a volunteer or contributing an item to the event. The beneficiary is the fund to educate seminarians who will be the future priests serving in our pastorate.

In the pastorate there is someone in the office in each parish (full or part-time) that works with Michele Snyder. She is the fiscal coordinator for each of the parishes and St. Joseph School. While maintaining the individuality of each entity we have reconciled the daily operations to the standards of the Diocese of Sioux Falls.

As announced before Amy Greba is the communication coordinator. She is working on websites, social media, bulletin, digital signage and all other areas of communication. We are moving forward but everything takes time in the church, so thank you to everyone who has contributed in some way.



"This Lent, God is asking us to examine whether in our lives, in our families, in the places where we work and spend our time, we are capable of walking together with others, listening to them, resisting the temptation to become self-absorbed and to think only of our own needs." ~Pope Francis

This is a great time to live out Lent together as a family. Here are a few ideas and activities you can do as a family.

We have a place at school where we go to pray. It is our prayer table. Statues and pictures of Jesus are kept there, along with Bibles, rosaries, and a cloth that displays the liturgical time of year. You can have a designated area like this to use to go to pray. You could even have a container to hold their special prayer intentions.

During the season of Lent, we do the Stations of the Cross every Friday at 2:30pm at the church. As a family, you could pray the Stations of the Cross, say a daily Lenten prayer, or read a Bible passage about Jesus' journey to the cross.

Virtues are always being referred to here at school. One of them is the virtue of kindness. As a family, you could practice that virtue with your children by participating in almsgiving. You could have a Lenten calendar where each day you do one good deed. You could collect money for a charity. You could also make a meal together and invite over a neighbor.

Crafts are always a fun way to spend time together. As a family, you could make a Lenten prayer chain. The chain could be made of prayers that are linked together. You could also plant a Resurrection garden. This could be an area where you plant flowers that will bloom by Easter.

It is never too late to be part of our family at St. Joseph Catholic School! We are not just educating the leaders of tomorrow, we are focused on using our faith and the Lord's teachings to make us ready to spend time with Him in Heaven. We would love to give you a tour and allow you to see how St. Joseph has




