Fr. Joe's Jottings

We are now in the last half of the season of Lent. Personally, my prayer, fasting and almsgiving have remained intact better than most years, but I hope in these final weeks to improve by taking time to embrace the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Following the tradition of the last few years, every registered household in Holy Rosary Pastorate should be receiving in the mail the schedule of Holy Week liturgies and confession times. It is hoped to give each parish and all the members opportunities to experience God love and mercy. Please embrace the grace that is being offered.

Amy Greba, communications director, is growing in her new position. She will continue to post information as she develops the pastorate website with each parish tab included. Also she will become more responsible for the format of the bulletin, but information submissions will continue as it has in the past year. Soon there we be a new digital sign at SS Peter and Paul. When that installation is completed, then there will be updating on the signs at St. Anthony of Padua and Sacred Heart.

The training that Fr. Holzhauser and Fr. Simon attended this last Tuesday in Sioux Falls was very good and challenges us to grow as priests. The Chrism Mass was a great celebration as the oil of the infirmed (sick), the oil of the Catechumenate (those joining the church), and the Sacred Chrisma (oil used for baptism, confirmation and ordination) were blessed. This ceremony is long (almost 2 hours) but is so very rich in symbolism and history. The norm for the priests is to gather with their bishop in each diocese on Holy Thursday morning and then return to their parishes for

the Last Supper Mass in the evening. This is not practical in rural areas; therefore, we gathered last week. We are in the last days of Lent, so keep praying, fasting and giving alms.




