Getting' Real with the Deacon

I have been reading a book from Pope Francis titled, "The Name of God is Mercy". During his first Mass as the Bishop of Rome in 2013, the Pope gave a homily on the woman whom the scribes and Pharisees were about to stone. Jesus saved her life by calling upon whoever was without sin to cast the first stone. Everyone walked away. Jesus told the woman: "Neither do I condemn you. Go and sin no more" (John 8:11).

Pope Francis went on to say that there are those who feel the need to be embraced and forgiven, but think they are irredeemable because they have done too many bad things. The Pope spoke about a man he counseled when he was a priest, who said, "Father, if you knew my life you wouldn't talk to me about mercy. I have done some terrible things!" Francis replied to the man, "Go to Jesus: he likes to hear about these things. He forgets, he kisses you, he embraces you, and he says: Neither do I condemn you. Go, and sin no more." Francis went on: "That is the only advice the Lord gives. If things don't change, go back to the Lord. The Lord never tires of forgiving: never! It is we who tire of asking him for forgiveness. We need to ask for the grace not to get tired of asking for forgiveness, because Jesus never gets tired of forgiving."

It is Palm Sunday and as we head into Holy Week and Easter there will be many opportunities to seek God's Mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Catholic Church doesn't reproach her flock for their fragility and their wounds, but instead she offers the medicine of mercy from the confessional. God awaits us with open arms; we need only take a step toward him. The message of Jesus is Mercy.
