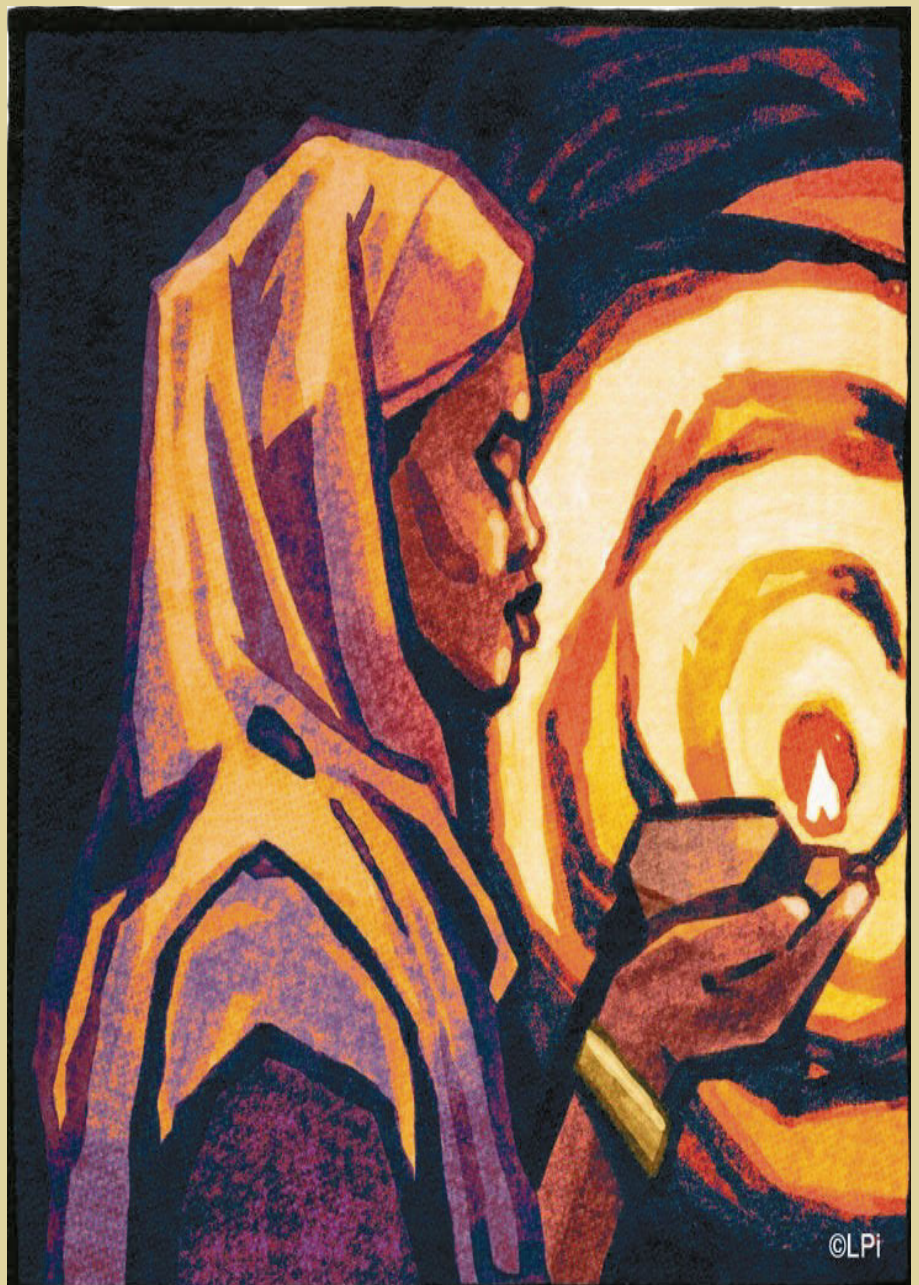

Getting' Real with the Deacon!

It was almost two years ago that Pope Francis invited us to a worldwide conversation on the Church when participants from across the Diocese participated in the “Synod on Synodality.” Last month cardinals, bishops, priests, and lay people met in Rome to discuss important matters in the life of the Church resulting from two years of listening to Catholics from around the world including the lay faithful in Sacred Heart, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Pius X, and SS Peter and Paul parishes. The Synod process is about walking together guided by the Holy Spirit. It expresses Pope Francis’ desire for a Church that goes out to the margins to bring Christ to everyone, while staying close to the world’s wounded.

Among topics reflected upon during the Synod were the role of women and the laity, the ministry of bishops, priesthood and the diaconate, the importance of the poor and migrants, and an openness to listening and accompanying those who have suffered abuse and hurt in the Church. Much of the Synod was devoted to the poor, who desire the Church’s respect, acceptance, and recognition. The poor were identified as not only the materially impoverished but also migrants; indigenous peoples; victims of violence and abuse (especially women), victims of racism and trafficking; people with addictions; minorities; abandoned elderly people; and exploited workers. Among “the most vulnerable of the vulnerable, on whose behalf constant advocacy is needed are children in the womb and their mothers”.

The Synod addressed the “need to accompany” people who feel marginalized or excluded from the Church because of their marriage status, identity, or sexuality”. The Assembly had a deep sense of love, mercy and compassion for those who have been hurt or felt neglected by the Church and those who seek a place to call ‘home’ where they can feel safe and respected without fear of judgement. Catholics are called to “Respect the dignity of the human person”.

Among the proposals made by the Synod was the request for study of the possibility of women deacons. The request to study women deacons received the most opposition of topics considered by the Assembly. They also addressed the need for new ministries for women or if the Church needs to create more space for women in existing ministries.

The Synod on Synodality will resume in 2024. Let’s all keep Pope Francis and the Synod participants in our prayers.

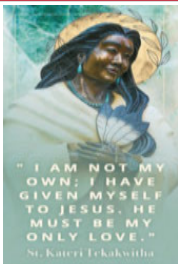

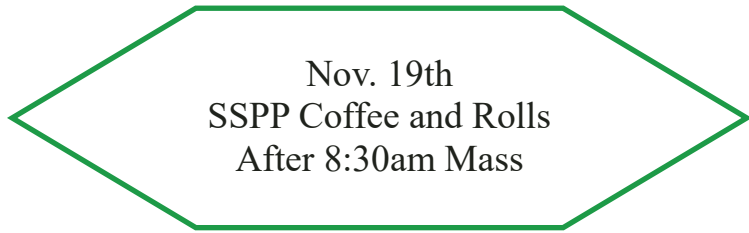

 All School Masses are my favorite. As you walk into the church, you see children from young Kindergarteners to mature 5th graders showing reverence to God. They enter quietly, genuflect as they enter the pew, and take a moment to say hi to God in prayer. Throughout the Mass, they understand how important it is to focus on what is happening. They know we are in the presence of God and soon we will be able to receive Him and that grace will stay with us the whole day! The choir of children sing angelically as they lead their peers in musical prayer.

There are so many things the students are learning by attending mass. They see it is a community of followers of Christ, not just the school but the parishioners as well. We may continue to age but our faith doesn't. They see how important faith is no matter what age. The students learn different ways to pray. Prayer can come from something that is written, such as the Eucharistic Revival prayer, Set Ablaze prayer, or Prayers of the Faithful. They learn it can come from the heart as Father speaks to us during the homily or prays the final blessing. They find comfort in the prayers such as the Prayer to St. Michael and the Litany of Saints. Finally and most importantly, they learn that God is completely present there with them. It is a sacred place, where graces are given through the Eucharist. They understand Jesus is in the Tabernacle and the Monstrance. They are given a chance to adore Him. What a beautiful gift! What a wonderful way to start the day!

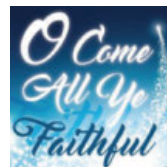

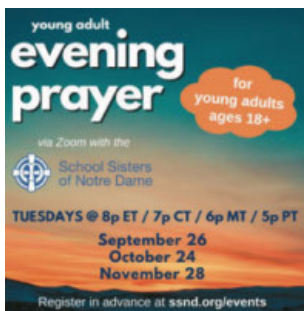
