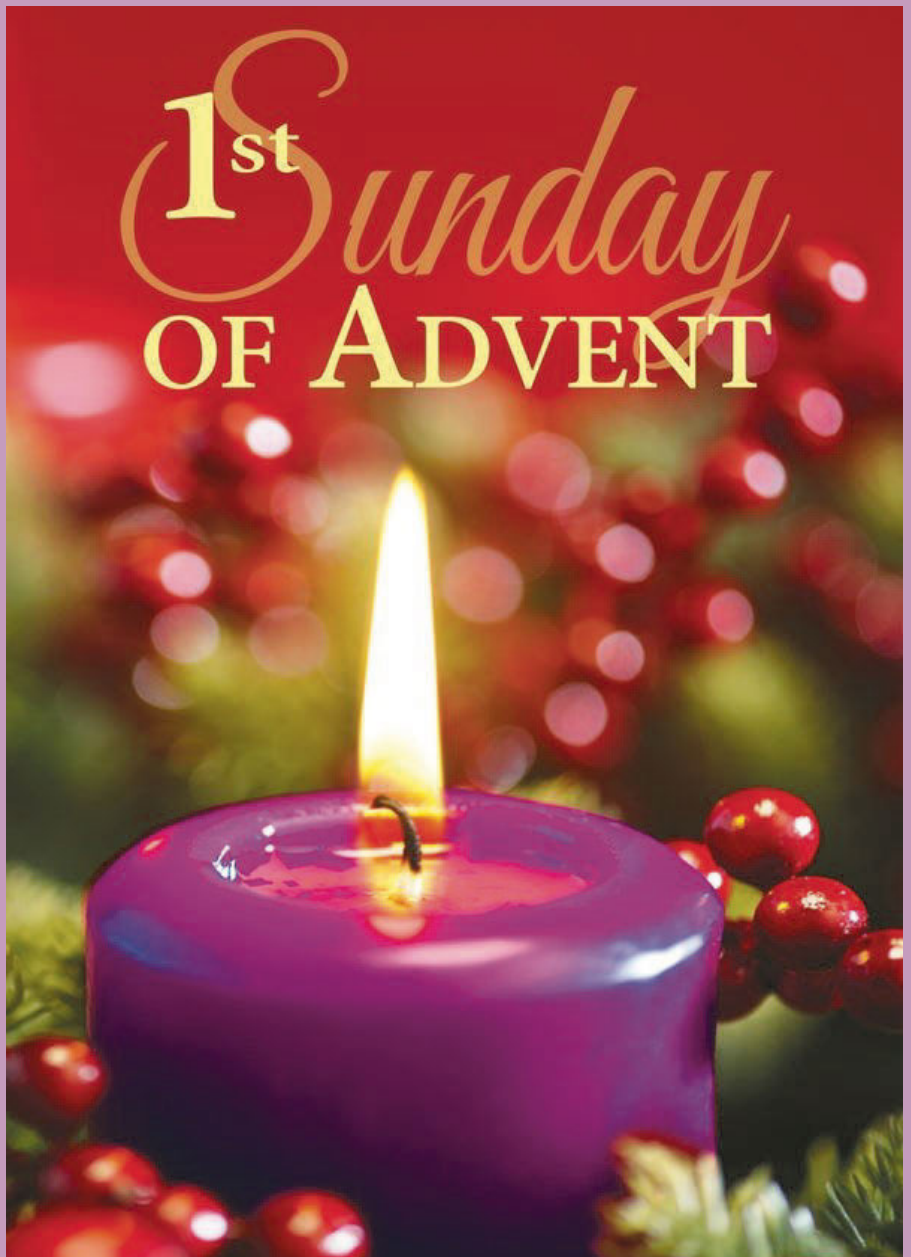

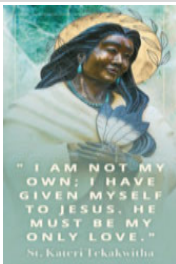

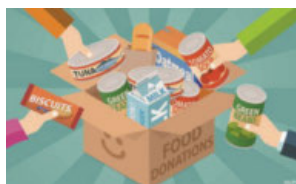

This is the beginning of Advent! The time we ready ourselves for the Christ child! Are we prepared for His coming? At St. Joseph Catholic School, we are using a curriculum called Absolutely Advent! The students will be following Levi the lamb and his shepherd, Ira, as they journey to see the Christ child.

Jesus said to his disciples, “Beware, keep alert; for you do not know when the time will come.”
Matthew 13:33.

We ask our students, why was Jesus warning his disciples to stay awake and be ready? Are their souls ready to be with Christ? Are our souls ready? What do we need to do to prepare?

The students will be given the opportunity to ready themselves through prayer, Mass, Reconciliation, and by being of service to their community. What can be done at home? Special traditions from decorating the house, putting up a Nativity scene, participating in an Advent calendar, lighting your Advent candles on your wreath, and giving to the less fortunate can be some of the activities that will help ready our souls for Jesus’ birth.

The students also learn about the Advent wreath. They learn that three of the colors are purple. Purple means there is something BIG about to happen. It is the color of hope! Those are lit on the 1st, 2nd, and 4th Sundays of Advent. On the 3rd Sunday, a rose candle is lit. It is the color of JOY! Christmas is near! Are you ready?

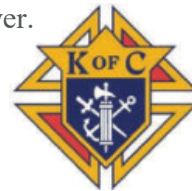
