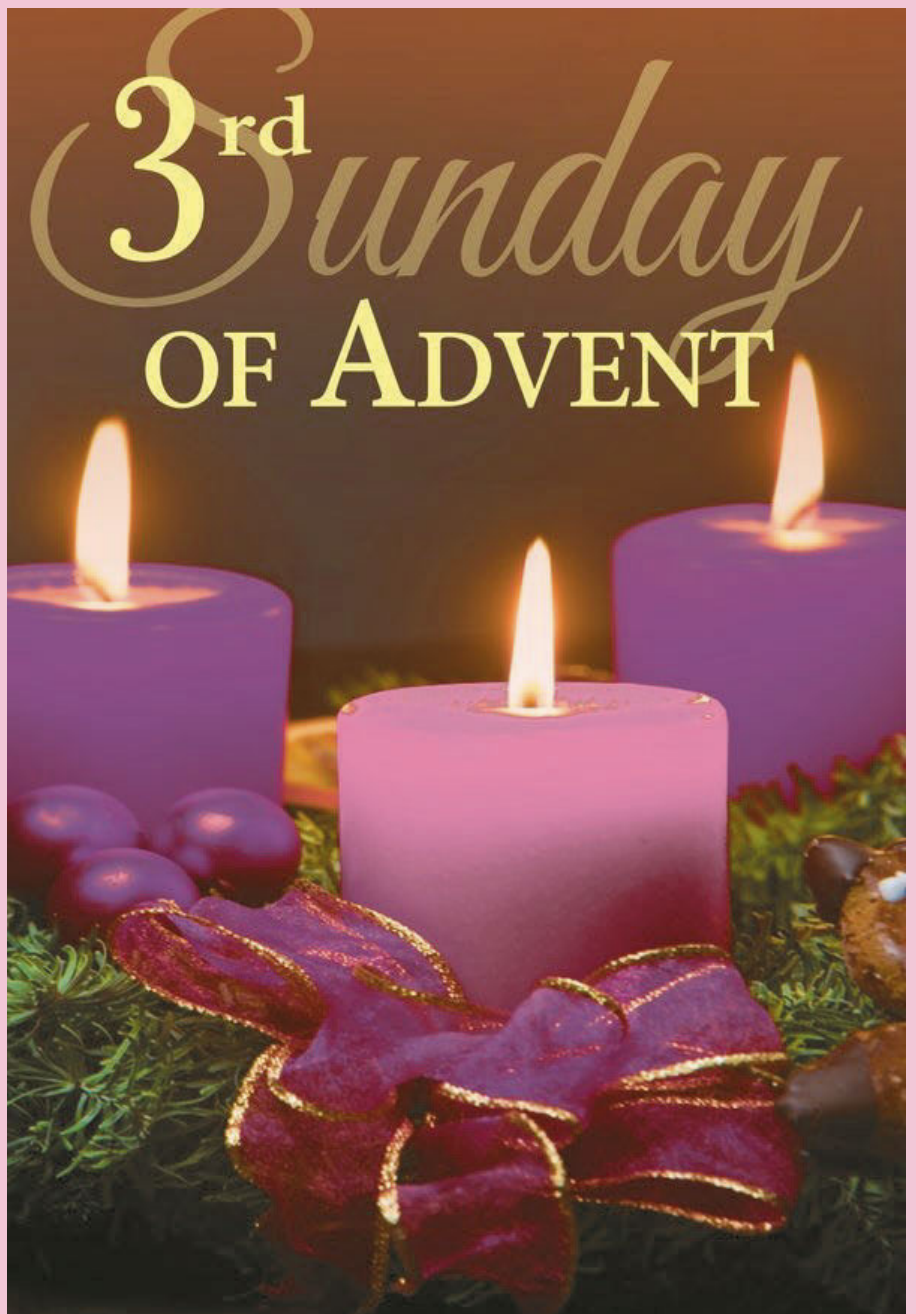

December 17, 2023 *3rd Sunday of Advent*



Fr. Simon Sez

This third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday (Rejoice Sunday) with the liturgical color being violet or rose. We continue our preparation for the coming of the Lord, but since the celebration of Christmas is near, we are joyful, because we realize the Lord has come among us to save us, and yet, we need Jesus to come to us -- Come, Lord Jesus!

On December 12th, we celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. She brought joy to the Aztec Indians of Mexico and to the Americas in 1531, just ten years after Hernando Cortes conquered the kingdom of Montezuma. The Mother of God appeared to Juan Diego as pregnant with the Child Jesus. Our Savior came to them through Mary, His Mother -- Come, Lord Jesus!

This event in salvation history converted an estimated eight to ten million Indians, bringing them into the Church and replacing those who left the Church in the Protestant Revolt during the same time period. It converted their hearts from offering an estimated 50,000 children each year to their blood-thirsty false gods who demanded from them the fresh hearts and blood of their children. Our Lady of Guadalupe brought joy to the Aztec Indians by leading the Church into battle over this culture of death. She purified their culture by calling the people to listen to the Church's missionary priests, to be baptized by them, and to follow the lay faithful like Juan Diego into true worship of the God of Joy and Life, welcoming the Lord Jesus into their lives -- Come, Lord Jesus!

We are joyful today in anticipation of Christmas, the Christ Child coming into our lives to bring us salvation. As the prophet Isaiah said in the first reading (Is 61:1-2a, 10-11), "I rejoice heartily in the Lord, in my God is the joy of my soul..." However, we know we have yet to receive Jesus into our lives fully. For this, we look to Mary, the Mother of God and our Mother, to help us make straight the way of the Lord by frequently celebrating the sacraments of Penance and Eucharist. Our preparation for Christmas also helps us to prepare for the glorious return of the Lord when the Lord will make all things new. For this, we pray -- Come, Lord Jesus!

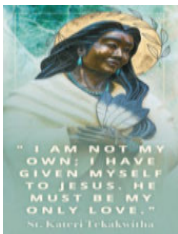

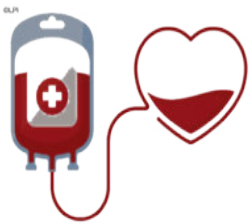
