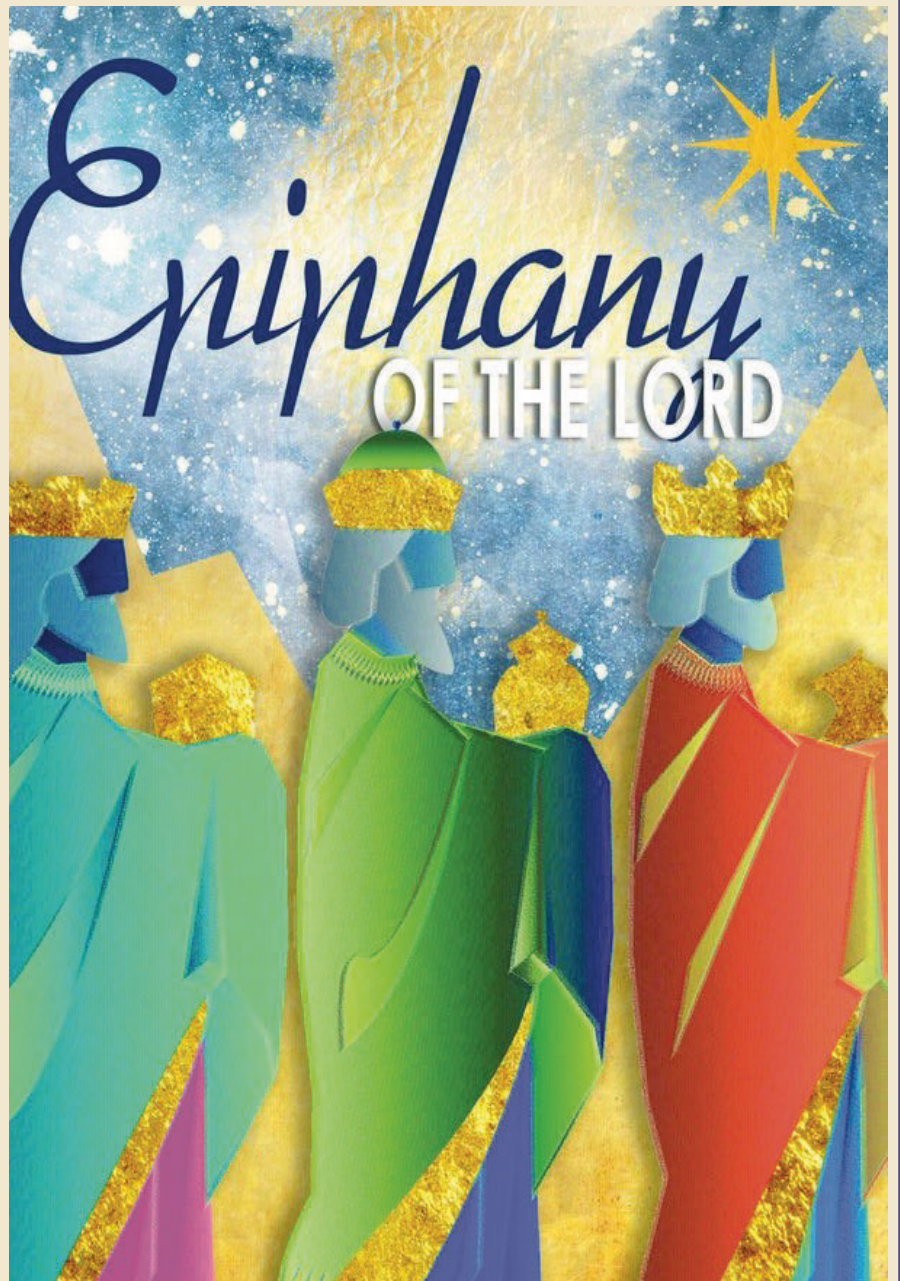

Fr. Joe's Jottings

The Solemnity of Epiphany is a joyful occasion as all Solemnities are. We reflect on the three magi from the east bringing those gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Many times, gifts convey a meaning. A ring conveys a commitment to another. The gold was indicative of Jesus' kingship while frankincense gave testimony to the sacrificial life and myrrh was a beacon to the death which would bring salvation.

As we heard last week in the gospel passages, Mary pondered what all this meant. She reflected on numerous events in those first years of her newborn son. The annunciation, visitation, incarnation, circumcision, purification, and presentation were some of the most significant. Mary had the wisdom to listen and contemplate. She didn't react immediately but rather responded with affirmation. Her fiat was to be a servant of the Lord.

We can follow her example by seeking out the gifts of the Holy Spirit, namely, wisdom, knowledge, and understanding. During the year of 2024, each person, regardless of age, is to pray about their calling to become lifelong Catholic Missionary Disciples. What is the gift that God has given you and what are you to do with that Gift, to share our beloved Catholic faith with the present and future generations?

Sometimes we need to be creative in the use of our talents and gifts, but we will only know God's plan if we begin and end with prayer. It is hoped that 2024 will be the year where each of us spends large durations of time before the Blessed Sacrament in silence so we can hear the voice of God. Please take time to be still and listen. May God bless each and everyone.

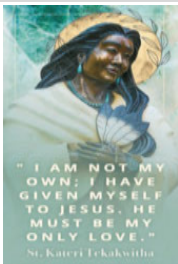
