Fr. Joe's Jottings

History is in the making with the establishment of pastorates throughout our diocese this weekend. In Pierre this is the last issue of the bulletin under the old format and all four parishes in the three-county area will be reading this column in a "homemade" version of the bulletin going forward. The publishing company will be "on board" next weekend. Just a reminder that all bulletin articles need to be submitted by noon each Tuesday. Obviously, there will be some adjustments as we go forward but we just need to look at the early days of the church to see that we have been here before.

Since we have just celebrated the day of the nation's independence, there is another example of the fledgling that is associated with new beginnings. I think of those original signors who risked so much to make this new nation. The organization of colonies into a unified nation. Did Virginia want to be New York and under the same leader? Who was to be responsible for which detail and how to maintain their independence as a "new" state? The growing pains we learn about in American history.

In the first century of Christianity, there were the tensions and the "unknowns" that lead to the first ecumenical council in Jerusalem. How to address the gentile converts while upholding Mosaic law? There were the "established" traditional who relished the old ways but there was also Paul, an apostle, with companions driven by the Holy Spirit to expand.
