Obviously, there will be some adjustments as we go forward but we just need to look at the early days of the church to see that we have been here before.

Since we have just celebrated the day of the nation's independence, there is another example of the fledgling that is associated with new beginnings. I think of those original signors who risked so much to make this new nation. The organization of colonies into a unified nation. Did Virginia want to be New York and under the same leader? Who was to be responsible for which detail and how to maintain their independence as a "new" state? The growing pains we learn about in American history.


