There may be some who haven't experienced a deacon serving during Mass or as part of their Parish community. Permanent Deacons lead "normal" lives outside of ministry in the Church. Gidget and I both work full-time for the City of Pierre and we joyfully share life with our four grown children and our eight grandchildren. One way we share this wonderful journey together is through ministry to ladies at the South Dakota Women's Prison. We have met so many wonderful women through prison ministry and often our prayer is for the ladies to receive half of the joy that we experience in our time together with them.

As ministers of Word, deacons proclaim the Gospel and preach now and then in the name of the Church. As ministers of Sacrament, deacons baptize, lead the faithful in prayer, witness marriages, and conduct wake and funeral services. As ministers of Charity, deacons are leaders in identifying the needs of others, then marshaling the Church's resources to meet those needs. Deacons are also dedicated to eliminating the injustices or inequities that cause such needs. 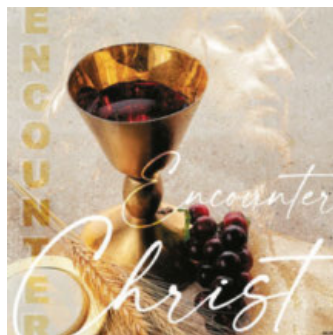

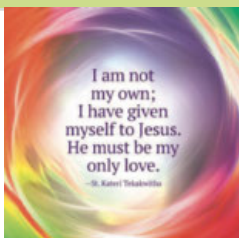

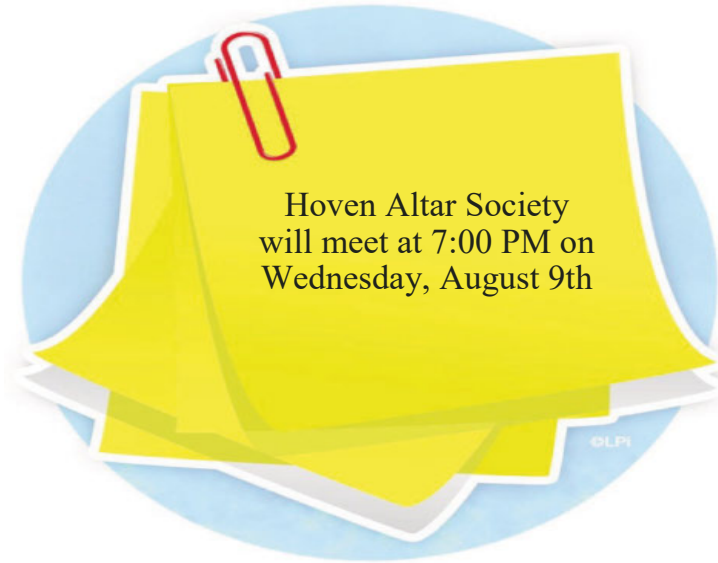
