

Fr. Simon Sez

I extend greetings in Christ to my dear faithful people of Pastorate #2! This has been an exciting and hope-filled experience introducing myself to parishioners of Saints Peter & Paul Parish in Pierre and to those parishioners of St. Anthony of Padua Parish in Hoven who do not already know me. I thank you for the warm and wonderful reception.

I will share with you some quick background information on me and a little on what you can expect as to my approach and objective through priesthood missionary discipleship. I grew up on a farm west of Hoven, SD which included summer ranching west river. I graduated from the SD School of Mines & Technology in 1985 with a BS degree in chemical engineering, worked for six years in the San Francisco Bay Area as a NAVY civilian employee testing plastic bonded explosives for shelf life in warheads from missiles, mines, and torpedoes. 


