

Fr. Joe's Jottings

Some of the queries that have arisen within the Pastorate. I would like to address this week.

Some have asked how one will know which priest will be celebrating a particular Mass. Presently one priest will travel the north circuit and the other takes the south circuit. The north circuit is comprised of Onida, Gettysburg and Hoven. Pierre is the only stop on the south route. It has been a tradition in this diocese that the presider's name isn't identified in advance because all priests celebrate the Holy Eucharist but with some uniqueness. Therefore, every week when one comes to Mass the answer to which priest is celebrant will become apparent.

Also, we are required under the pastorate guidelines to submit to the diocesan offices the number of attendees at each Mass. In Pierre, the ushers gather a count and record; in Onida, the greeters are responsible to count and record; in Gettysburg, the music people have that task; in Hoven, we have had a couple of volunteers. The best time is between the offertory and the rite of communion so that we count those who may be late for some reason and those who have obligations that make it necessary to leave early.

To standardize the opening of the Holy Mass in this pastorate, there will be someone who reads a little introduction and announces the opening hymn. Therefore, we will need to have all our ministers arriving early enough to be focused by praying before Mass. There are still openings of service for more volunteers.

Very soon we begin the faith formation classes and study which will also need a labor force. Pray to the master of the harvest to send more laborers.




