Getting' Real with the Deacon

This weekend's readings tell us we have no need for fear and anxiety, for Jesus is always close, even in the noise of the world. As Christians we are called to be not of the world, but we are called to be in the world. Our call is to help people recognize the presence of Jesus and to let them know that in a stormy world Jesus can be a source of peace.

In the reading from Matthew, Jesus is not in the boat; he is in the stormy waters. It is interesting that Jesus is found outside the boat in the middle of the stormy sea, in the world. We are called to step out in faith to meet him. To have enough faith that we might be a water-walker who seeks and finds Jesus by keeping our eyes and our hearts focused on him and by recognizing Jesus in the lives of others who share our walk in their own stormy waters.

I imagine all of us can think of some remarkable water-walkers we have known. We all know simple, straight-forward, hard-working men and women, toddlers and teens, shut-in elders and shut-out homeless. perform acts that defy the limitations of the world in which they live. The dialysis patient who gets out of bed, puts on clean clothes and picks up around the house, before going for treatment. The incarcerated woman who is separated from her children, struggles with addiction, but still smiles a greeting and cares more about the struggles of others than her own. The single parent who is overworked and overwhelmed but still makes it to soccer games and school plays and checks to see that homework is done. The elderly man or woman who lives alone, whose family has forgotten them, who counts the meals on wheels volunteer as "company," but still sits at the table for all their meals. They can all be considered water walkers who seek and find Jesus in the world.

I encourage everyone to seek out a water-walker this week and to share a word of encouragement with them. When we do that, we can bring a bit of peace into their world and help them see what Jesus' love looks like.

St. Joseph School is like a family. As a family we are united in striving for the best of each member. To do that, we hire exceptional people. I would like to introduce you to some of them.


