Fr. Joe's Jottings

Two weeks ago the bulletin contained information about many numbers. Another number to be added to those was the odometer reading from my vehicle. There is over 100,000 miles and growing. It is hoped that another number will grow as well: The number of volunteers to assist in the Faith Formation programs in each parish. At almost every Mass, it seems more times than not, we are looking for someone to cover the various liturgical roles. The intent of the Set Ablaze restructuring is for more individuals to embrace the opportunities to become more involved. I do believe that one additional ministry that is needed is people committed to prayer especially before the Blessed Sacrament.

Every one of the churches in this pastorate is open many hours of every day to facilitate the accessibility to adoration of the Holy Eucharist. The power of prayer is beyond comprehension, but underdeveloped. The number of people going to daily Mass could be expanded. It would be truly amazing if more people would stop for about 10 minutes before the tabernacle during the day. I remember in former parishes so many would pray a few short prayers and then light a votive candle before continuing with the rest of the tasks of the day.

At each end of the pastorate, namely, Hoven and Pierre, there are Adoration Chapels. Anyone who wishes can contact either parish can gain access to those chapels for personal, private prayer for the needs of the pastorate. There are many prayer groups and prayer chains, but we could expand the number of people who are willing to pray in the privacy of their homes at specific hours of the day. Again, the power of prayer can accomplish so much. Jesus states that through prayer and fasting nothing is impossible.


