Fr. Joe's Jottings

Almost everyone is in the mode of learning because almost all our young people are in some structure of educational environments. The next generation will always need to be mentored by the last generation. In the beginning, Adam and Eve needed to enlighten Cain and Abel about appropriate and inappropriate actions. Therefore, today, we continue that as parents, grandparents, and Godparents - we give directions and examples to those who are younger. The cliché is that we never get too old to learn; likewise we never get too old to teach. With age comes wisdom; which assumes that as we age, we become more prudent in our decisions.

With the start of another year of faith formation, the reality is that we always need more volunteers to assist in the transferal of dogma and doctrine by not only word but by deed. We continue to seek role models that may not be the best public orators, but their actions speak louder than their words. As pastor I invite everyone to pray about what the plan that God has for you in this pastorate. Something as simple as spending time in prayer while the students are in session will have a very powerful influence as the Holy Spirit will descend upon the young with gifts and fruits.

Finally, I wish to express my gratitude for so many summer staff members and volunteers in each of the parishes of the pastorate that have kept the facilities and grounds in a standard that is extremely dignified. When I look at the \$41,381,000.00 (total replacement value) of physical structures between the four towns, we need to be good stewards and that requires funding but also labor. If I were to list all the names, it would be extensive, but they really are deserving of our prayers of gratitude. Each one of us makes the community of believers stronger by our commitment.

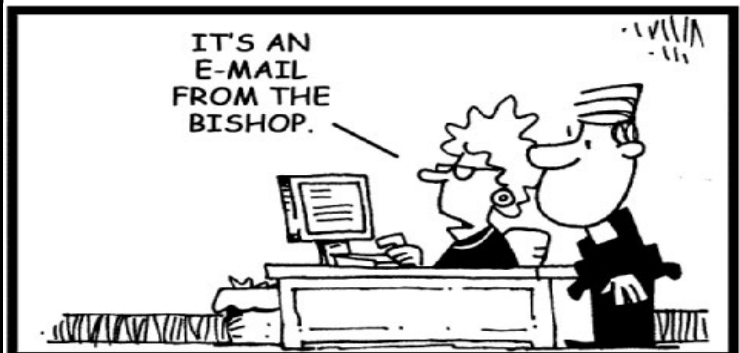

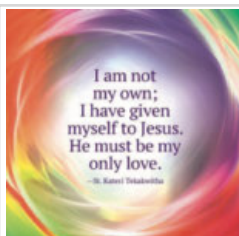
