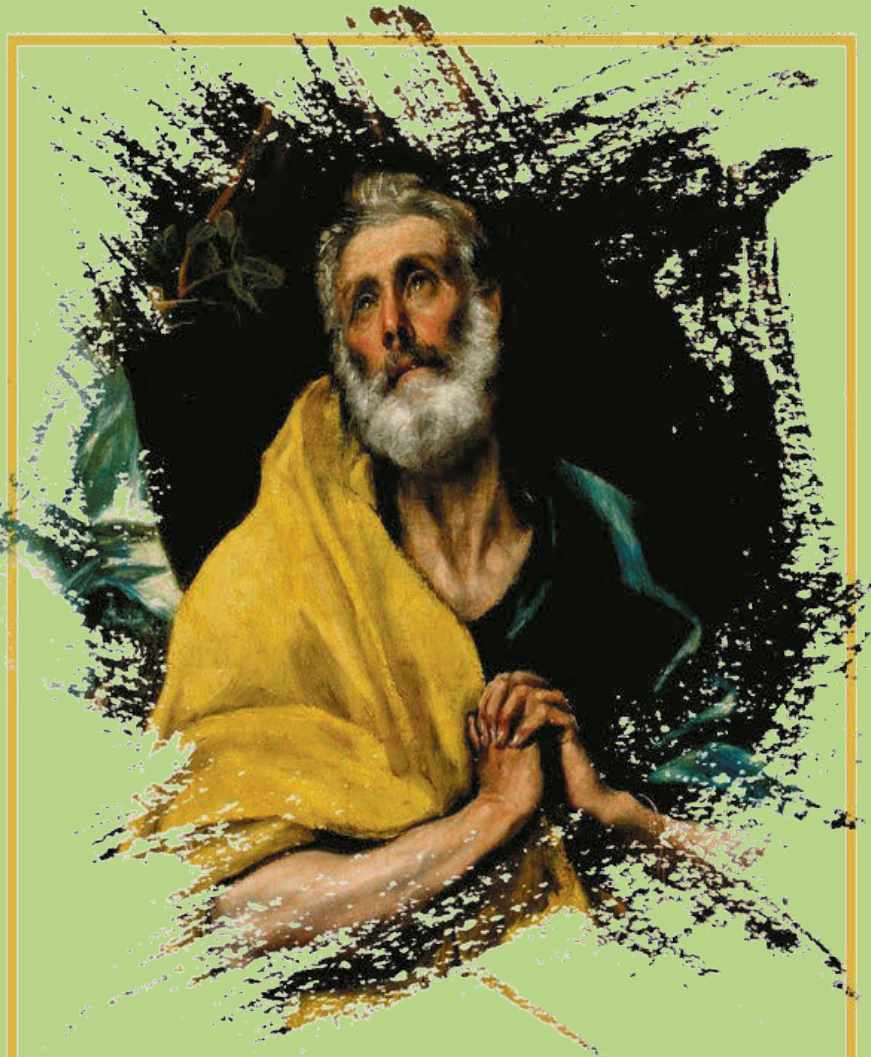

Fr. Simon Sez

The Importance of the Fullness of the Christian Faith: What is the purpose of spirituality, religion, and faith for you? Ultimately, what is the goal for you? What will work best for you and your loved ones to live the fullness of life here and now as well as reach your ultimate goal, eternal life in heaven?

As you probably know, Christianity is the largest religion in the United States, but it is also in the fastest decline. What is the problem? It is hard to say. What should really matter to us as individuals and families, instead, is to not get caught into this decline but to excel instead. What matters to me and probably, to most people, is what is practical. What is practical is what actually proves out to work for you and your loved ones. If people experience Christianity as truly working for them, they would not only stick with it, but also, seek to live it to the fullest. What does that take? It takes the fullness of the Christian faith and practicing it. We cannot be lacking in any truth in belief or practice; otherwise, we may be deceived and go astray like sheep without a shepherd. Of course, Jesus knew this. He told his disciples to “make disciples...teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.” (Matt 28:19-20.)

Catholics have the opportunity to learn more about their faith and receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, if needed. 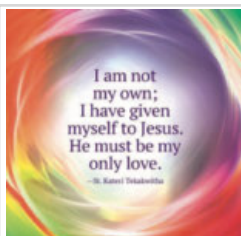

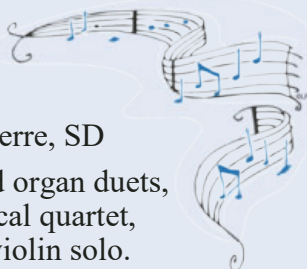
