

Fr. Joe's Jottings

Recently there was a pastorate planning leadership team established. The members are Jacob Rausch, Dan Glodt, Bob Dahlquist, Andy Mikkelsen, Nick Wiley, Taecea Voorhees, Becky Walsh, Patrick Ludwig, Tony Mangan, Darlene Braun, Michele Snyder, Fr. Brian Simon, and Fr. Joe Holzhauser.

On September 13th they met with Fr. Scott Traynor and Mr. Thad Pals. Fr. Traynor is the director of Discipleship and Evangelism while Mr. Pals is the Chancellor for the diocese.

During the three-hour meeting, Fr. Traynor identified the priorities of the pastorate during the next 8 months. He suggested that we identify a patron saint or significant event in salvation history. He also suggested that the first decision would NOT be Mass times and locations, but that is the LAST of 13 steps. He also stated that many people will want to start there.

After establishing a name, we are then to focus on Worship followed by Discipleship and Evangelization. The third priority will be Service which will foster community. There are 10 more steps, but we begin with a name for the pastorate. I grew up in Holy Rosary parish in Agar, while some were members of Holy Spirit in Blunt, and more recently, some remember St. John the Baptist in Onaka. I remember when naming the combination of parishes in Huron, I was in favor of All Saints, but the people wanted Holy Trinity for the three parishes.

Questions to be asked about Worship will be "Where we are, where we want to go, and how do we get there?" During this time of Eucharistic Revival, it is so very important that we focus on worship because that is our Catholic identity. The follow up will be Discipleship and Evangelization or catechesis. It is time to emphasize Real Presence and Adoration because many Catholics are not as strong as they once were in their faith. Mass attendance indicates we may have lost our commitment and devotion to the Blessed Sacrament.

That is enough for now but we have a busy 8 months coming.




