



Everyone has emotions. They are constantly changing, which therefore determines how we express them. Our emotions come out through our movements, interactions, and facial expressions. They are hard to disguise.

I had the joy of talking about emotions, and how we express them with each of the classes through an art project. We talked about the definition of emotion. The students gave examples of a multitude of emotions. When I would act one out, they were able to tell by the way I expressed myself what emotion it was. They could identify the emotion just by my movements and facial expressions. We then talked about how we can express emotions through our art, how some movements and colors express what we are feeling.

As Kids of Christ, we need to learn how to express our emotions in ways that do not disrupt others. We need to know how to work through our emotions and where we can go to find that safe place. God gave us emotions for a reason. They help us deal with problems and communicate with others. It is funny how the smallest among us can interpret almost any emotion because of how it is expressed.

The program 'Circle of Grace' helps the students put their emotions into words in a safe place with a trusted adult. The students are taught that the Circle of Grace is the space around each of us where we believe the Holy Spirit resides. The students determine what enters the holy space around them. They are taught strategies to help them express their emotions safely and with kindness.


