

October 15, 2023 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time



Father Simon Sez

In this Sunday's gospel proclamation (Matthew 22:1-14), Jesus teaches us about the kingdom of heaven by telling a parable of a king who gave a wedding feast for his son. The invited guests refused to come, with some of them killing the king's servants, even after the second invitation! He sent more servants out to the main roads to invite all people, the bad and good alike. The king came to meet the guests and saw a man there not dressed in a wedding garment. He asked him, "My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?" The man was reduced to silence; so, the king had his attendants cast him out into the darkness where there will be "wailing and grinding of teeth."

God invites all people, the bad and good alike, to his heavenly banquet, but that does not mean that anyone can come as they are. Many people think the kingdom of heaven is a "come as you are" party, coming on their own terms instead of God's terms. No, we all must be wearing a wedding garment, a white robe similar to those worn by the great multitude from every nation, tribe, people, and tongue that John saw standing before the throne and before the Lamb. One of the elders told John, "These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb" (Revelation 7:9-14).

God invites all people to come to the banquet of heaven, but few are chosen. We do not know with absolute certitude if we will be chosen until God judges us each individually after our own individual death. We can know with moral certitude if we are prepared for this judgment by wearing the wedding garment and keeping it white by the grace of God. God purifies us in Baptism and gives us the white wedding garment to wear through the tribulation of our lives by the grace of the sacraments. If we seek a holiness of life and die in the state of grace, we will be able to join the chorus in heaven rejoicing as mentioned in the first reading (Isaiah 25:10), "Behold our God, to whom we looked to save us! This is the Lord for whom we looked; let us rejoice and be glad that he has saved us!"


