

This week there will be young people in costumes searching for morsels of sugar, namely candy, in the tradition called Halloween. It is exciting to watch the creativity some families possess. In the life of the church the next day is more important by the fact that it is All Saints Day. It is hoped that we utilize this opportunity to catechize our children that gathering "treats" is good but reflecting on the communion of Saints leads to salvation. November 1 is a Holy Day of Obligation so as families we attend Mass.

On November 2nd, the church asks us to pray for all the souls of those who have died. A long tradition of the church is the souls of those not canonized are in purgatory. Purgatory is the state of existence where we are not in heaven but awaiting the "purification" of the soul so that we are worthy to enter the Kingdom. Many good people die without the last rites or without confessing all their sins. God forgives but we realize that we need to be in a state of "grace" to enter heaven so it is the teaching that Purgatory is the state of existence where the grace is attained through the prayers of so many people.

At each of the parishes we will have a book with the list of names of those who have died in the last year so that we can pray for their souls and all the souls of the faithful departed. Everyone can add to the list of names throughout the month of November. Perhaps one may want to walk through a cemetery and pray over the remains while looking at the monument with the names. Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord and let perpetual light show on them as they rest in peace.


