

Getting' Real with the Deacon

The world of nature around us experiences a continual changing of seasons, from Spring into Summer; from Fall into Winter. The seasons in South Dakota give variety to our souls so that we do not become bored with the sameness of an unchanging environment. A similar occurrence is experienced in the liturgical year of the Catholic Church.

In the early church Christians followed the Jewish calendar, but through the centuries they began to set themselves apart from the Jewish tradition. One of the first things they did was to choose Sunday as their "sabbath" followed by annually honoring the Passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. This was the most important time of the year for Christians and all other feasts were instituted in relation to the paschal events.

What we have now in the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church is the culmination of roughly 2,000 years of development, patterning the church year after the life of Jesus Christ. The liturgical year is made up of six seasons:

<u>Advent</u> – four weeks of preparation before the celebration of Jesus' birth

<u>Christmas</u> – recalling the Nativity of Jesus Christ and his manifestation to the peoples of the world

<u>Lent</u> – a six-week period of penance before Easter Sacred Paschal Triduum – the holiest "Three Days" of the Church's year, where the Christian people recall the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus

<u>Easter</u> – 50 days of joyful celebration of the Lord's resurrection from the dead and his sending forth of the Holy Spirit

Ordinary Time – divided into two sections (one span of 4-8 weeks after Christmas Time and another lasting about six months after Easter Time). During Ordinary Time we encounter Jesus' teachings and works among his people.

The mystery of Christ, unfolded through the cycle of the year, calls us to live his mystery in each of our lives. We need variation, both in the natural world and in the spiritual world. Through this liturgical year, let's immerse ourselves in the life of Christ, keeping our hearts open to spiritual renewal.


