

January 21, 2024 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time



Father Simon Sez

Many years ago, we knew there would come a time when Gettysburg and Hoven would have to share the same priest. My mother Alice Simon, who lives in Hoven, knew Fr. Joe Holzhauser for many years. His parents moved from Agar to Gettysburg. Once in awhile, they saw each other and debated about what would happen when the two towns have to share the same priest. The debate was about in which town the priest would live. Fr. Joe said, "Obviously, he's going to live in Gettysburg." My mother said, "The priest needs to live in Hoven! There have been about twelve priests and twenty-five religious sisters that came from Hoven. Not a single religious or priest vocation came from Gettysburg. If you want more priests, the priest needs to live in Hoven!"

Reflect on how blessed we are right now instead of bemoaning the past. This is where we are, here and now. We have two priests in our pastorate, and we have the Eucharist. Always having two priests in our pastorate with a priest residing locally in this northern area of our pastorate is not a given. What are you going to do about it? That is the question.

Our bishops of the United States are leading a Eucharistic revival to help facilitate a revival in our Church. Our Bishop Donald DeGrood is leading our diocese, the local Church, to bring this revival into our hearts and lives. The Eucharistic Heart of Jesus is at the heart of the Church. This is what we desperately need if we want vibrant parishes, pastorates, and dioceses.

We need you to engage in this Eucharistic revival. One of the first things to do is to pick up free books in our church gathering spaces titled, Beautiful Eucharist from Dynamic-Catholic.com. It is focused on how Jesus is truly present in the Most Holy Eucharist, and how you can personally encounter him in such a way that it results in transforming your life to become more like him, maybe even inspire more single men to become priests!

Can you stop by a Catholic church with Jesus in the tabernacle and spend ten minutes with him? At each visit, can you prayerfully read just one chapter of this book at a time, reflect on it, and see what Jesus has planned for you? Can you encourage others to do the same?

How important is it for you to have a Catholic church in your area so that you can stop to pray in the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and be able to attend Mass on a regular basis? Is it important enough for you to do whatever you can to foster and support priests who dedicate their lives to make the Eucharist available for you? I certainly appreciate all of you who pray for me and support me, including expressing this by way of Christmas cards and New Year's well wishes.

The ongoing debate that my mother Alice Simon and Fr. Joe had is an example of how important it is for them to have a priest in their home areas, even as a resident if possible. The first priest that Hoven and Gettysburg had to share is me, Fr. Brian Simon from Hoven, the son of Alice Simon. I chose to live in Gettysburg for practical reasons. And now you know ... the rest of the story.
