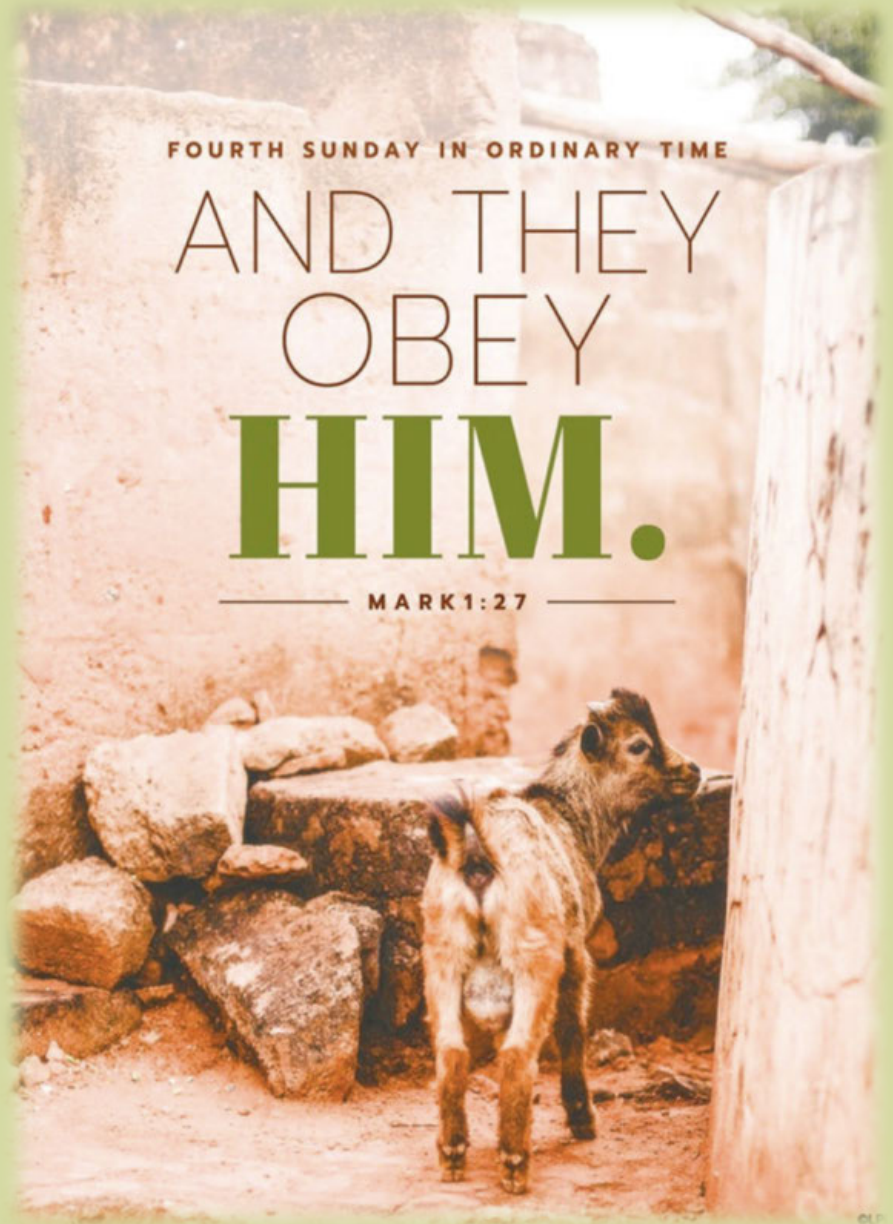

Going forward with the Set Ablaze guidance, we need to have as much information as possible of all Catholics.

There are many generous people in our pastorate which is very fortunate. Some people are unable to be as generous with financial support, but we do always need time and talent donations. Everyone needs to give praise to God for all that He has given us. I do invite everyone to show gratitude to our loving God in whatever way possible. We have received the numbers for Catholic Family Sharing Appeal 2024. They are very close to last year so it is hoped that together we can collaborate in each parish to collect as we have in the past. I will be sending a letter to each household about the importance of this annual appeal and the numbers for each respective parish. If possible, we may have to challenge ourselves to make up for those who have died and will not be giving this year. As the pastor I always try to lead by example, so I make my pledge first. I am personally appreciative for how CFSA helped to finance my seminary expenses over 40 years ago. I look forward to when CFSA will be assisting me with my retirement allowance.

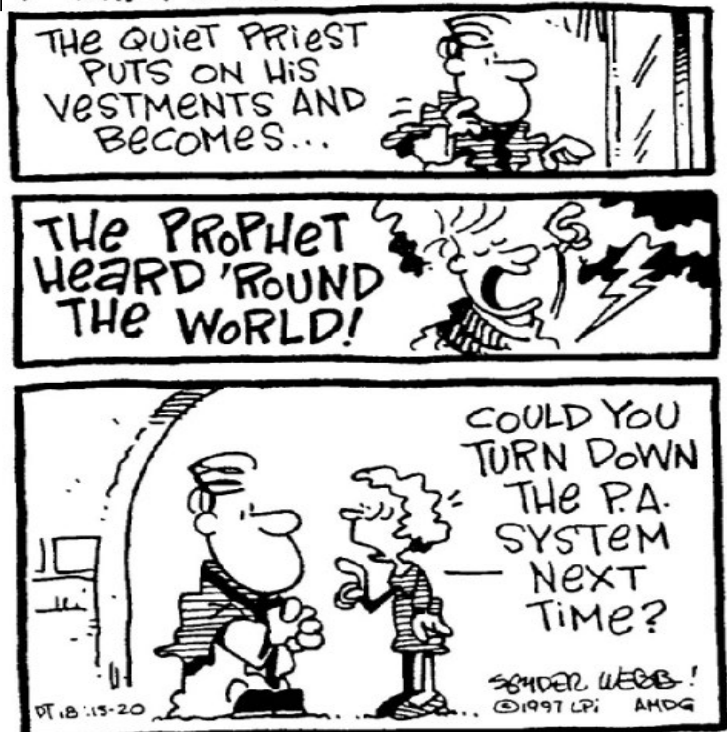

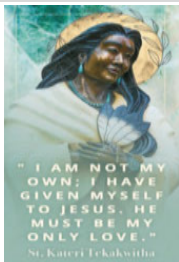
