#### Fr. Joe's Jottings

This past week the Set Ablaze survey for our pastorate was launched. Everyone for whom we have an email should have received a message with a link to the survey. There is a QR code in this bulletin and a link on <u>sspeterpaul.net</u> for those who wish to access the survey in those ways. The survey will be available until February 16th. The responses will be tabulated and reviewed by the Pastorate Planning Committee. In March there will be townhall meetings to discuss with the public. In April we will prepare a proposal for Bishop DeGrood to review in May. The proposal will address some ministries for the future and how to achieve those goals. This may seem to be a little "tight" schedule of events, but the deadline is May 1st to present the proposal to Bishop DeGrood.

Quite honestly, both priests have been attempting to the best of their abilities to fulfill the daily obligations for each parish. I do ask that everyone pray for Fr. Simon and myself, as well as each other. During the last few months, the prayers for Eucharistic Revival and Set Ablaze have been offered at every Mass so that the Holy Spirit would guide each of us during this process. It was the intention that everyone would become more eucharistic-centered and open to whatever changes that are necessary to share our beloved Catholic faith with the present generation and the future.

In hindsight, I do hope the limitations of the priests have not negatively affected the ministries of the parishes. Last weekend, Bishop DeGrood spent time at the Capital advocating respect for all human life. During that time, he also encouraged Fr. Simon and me to reflect on what it means to be happy, healthy, hardworking, and holy priests. Sometimes we have not been able to do what some have thought we should be able to do. That drives home the reality of the humanity of all our priests. Both of us appreciate the support that we have received, especially the spiritual backing. I was able to share with Bishop DeGrood that our parishioners are not perfect or sinless, but they are striving towards holiness. I do appreciate all the positive prayerful words so I look forward to our potential to inspire other pastorates.
