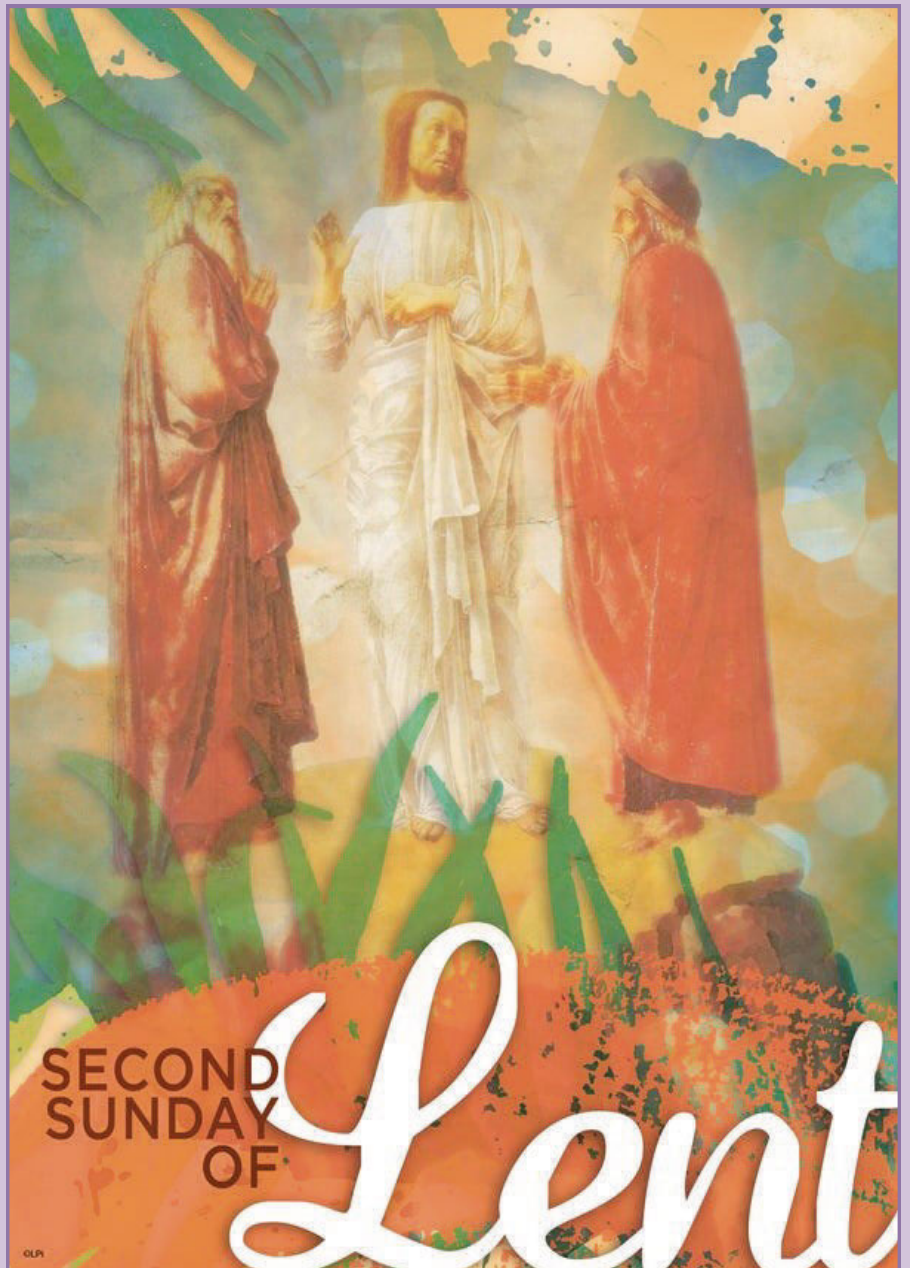

Fr. Joe's Jottings

As most know, this past week I was in Arizona with my mother and her relatives. My father always told us children that they are your mother's relatives not his or ours. So we always believed him. Quite honestly, my mother has admitted that my family was well received for the last 70 years by all the in-laws. As we close the month of February, it is the month about marriage and includes the secular event of Valentine's Day. February 14 is the feast day of Saints Cyril and Methodius. I do cherish the witness of husbands and wives in the sacrament of Matrimony because they are demonstrative of the love between Christ and His bride, Holy Mother Church.

This past week while I was gone, close friends of mine (one of mom's relatives) buried their 49 year-old daughter, another victim of cancer who lived out this quote from Stuart Scott. When you die, it does not mean that you lose to cancer. You beat cancer by how you live, why you live and in the manner in which you live. I was fortunate to be in Tara's life through her Confirmation, wedding, and the baptism of her children. She was remarkable. Another significant person to me was Bishop Peter Muhich. 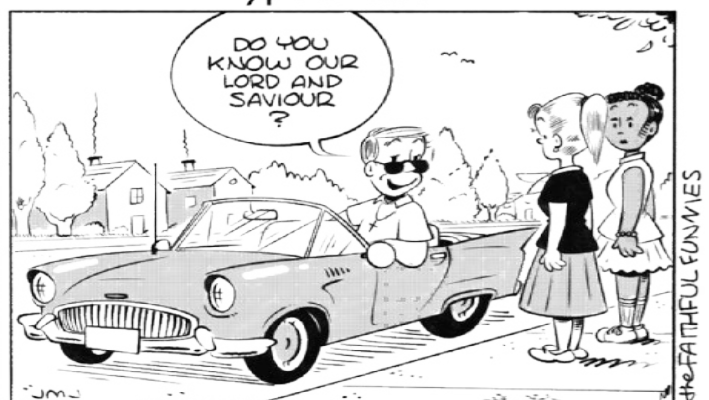

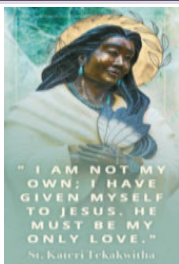

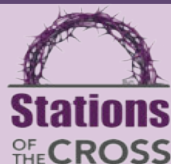
