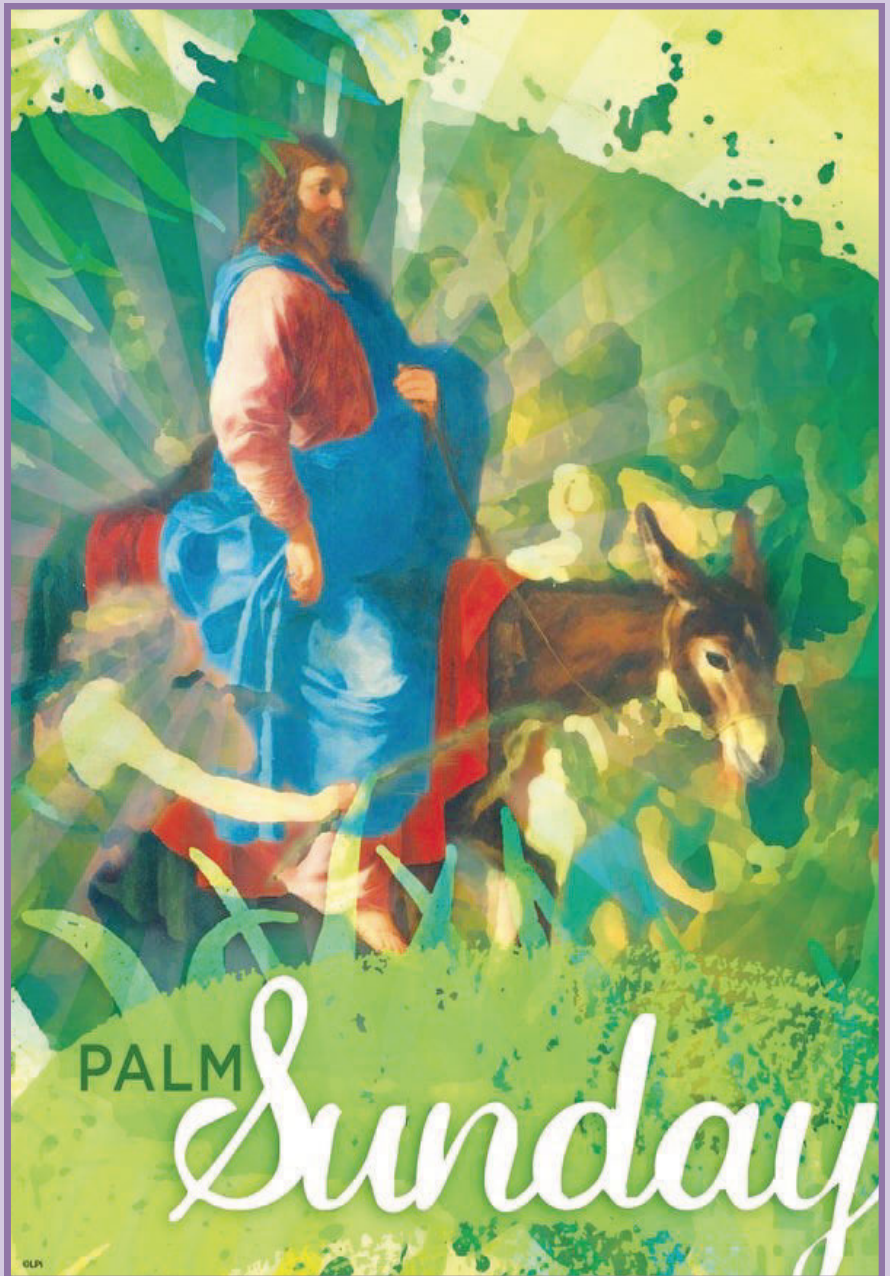

March 24, 2024 *Palm Sunday, 6th Sunday of Lent*



Fr. Joe's Jottings

Today we celebrate the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. If we were to envision being there 2000 years ago when he came riding in on that four-legged beast of burden, we can wonder what our attitude would be. Would any of us be like the chief priests of the time? Would we be caught up in the excitement of the crowd? Would we be apathetic like the Romans? In hindsight, we can see the faults of everyone that day because we know the rest of the story. Because we have the advantage of history, the question for us today is how do I proclaim to others the importance of Holy Week?

One option is to experience the Sacrament of Reconciliation and invite others to receive the graces of that sacrament as well. Another option is to read the passion narrative from John's Gospel in preparation for the public proclamation on Good Friday. Another option would be to spend additional time in prayer, or additional resources in almsgiving or additional penance or increased fasting. Perhaps one will share the letter that was delivered this past week with the days and times in preparation for the Holy Triduum?

Last Sunday and this Sunday were the townhall meetings, giving us background to the Set Ablaze Restructuring. It is hoped that everyone will have a better understanding of where we were, where we are going and how do we get there. So many changes have been in the life of the church and in every one of our lives over the past 50 years. Throughout my priesthood, one question has always been there, "what does God want of me" because "I know what I want to do for Him, but is it what He wants?" During this final week of Lent, each of us can embrace humility and docility during our time of reflection to hear His voice calling us.

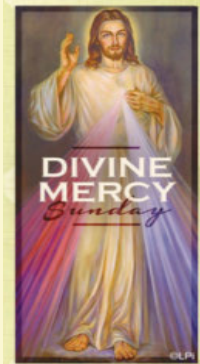
