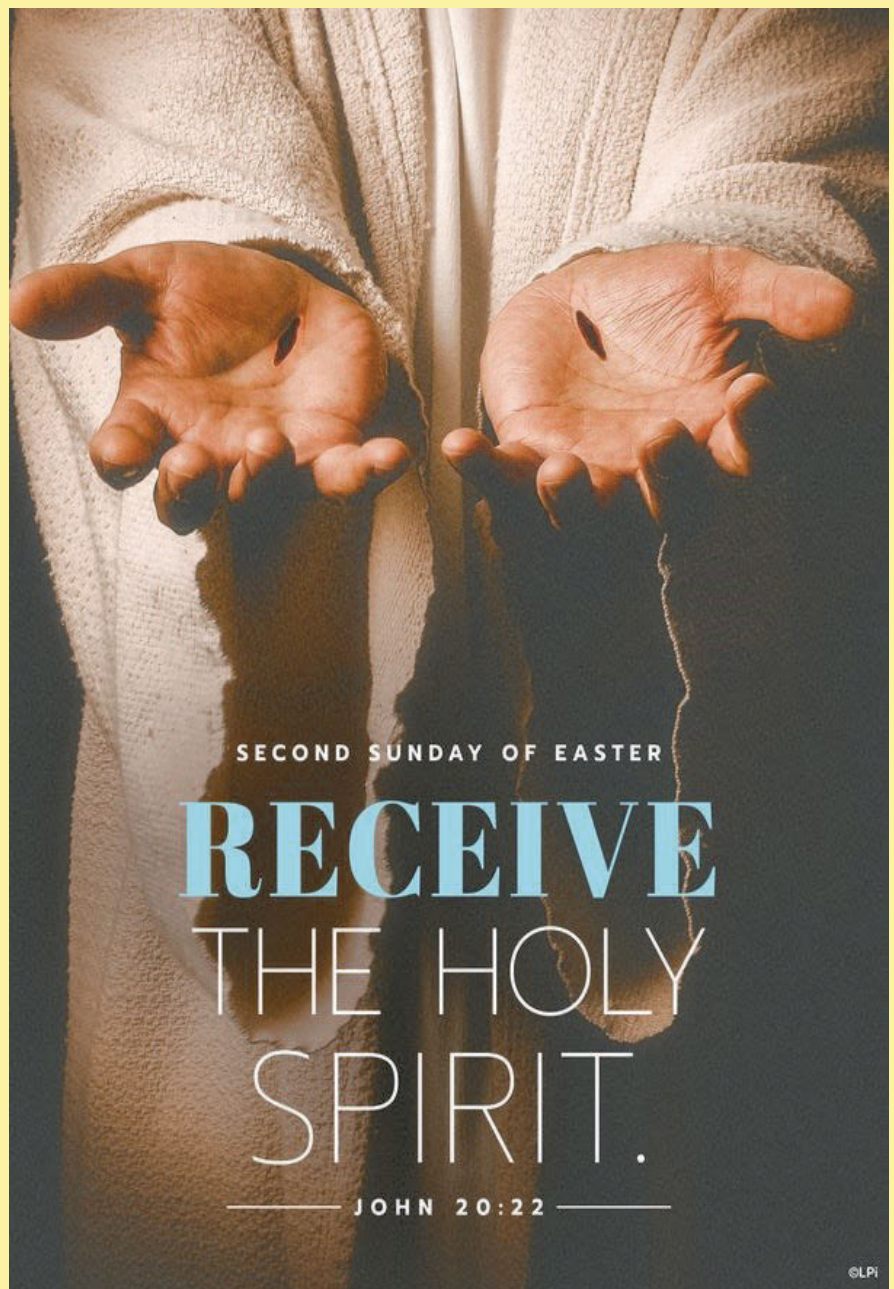

He is Risen!

Another busy weekend in the pastorate. Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. On Holy Thursday and Good Friday at SS Peter and Paul Church, an informational page was handed out by the That Man Is You men's group. It explained the proper way to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. If one searches on the internet that information can be found there as well. It is important and prudent to pray the Chaplet. The traditional time is 3:00pm but almost any time is better than not praying.

Another event this weekend is the reception of First Holy Communion by the little ones of Sacred Heart Parish, Gettysburg. At the 10:30am Mass, these candidates, with much dignity and respect, will come forward to participate in receiving the Real Presence of Jesus Christ. They made their First Reconciliation on Saturday in anticipation of this solemn event. May they never lose their excitement for the Blessed Sacrament. Some of us adults are inspired by the next generation of believers.

Finally, the make-up session of the Pastorate townhall meeting that was planned for March 24th will be on Sunday afternoon. We will begin at 3:00pm in Sacred Heart Parish Hall, Gettysburg. On this Divine Mercy Sunday, it is hoped that the time will be beneficial to the Pastorate Planning Team as they will spend that last two weeks of April writing a master plan for the future of ministry in this area. For those not attending the meeting, I am asking that during that time they pray the Chaplet.

Next weekend, the young people from SS Peter and Paul Parish will be receiving their First Holy Communion. It will not be long until our high school students in Pierre and Gettysburg will be "sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit" in the Sacrament of Confirmation. Around the corner is the month of May which is the end of the academic year. Just as always, the past 9 months have come and gone so very fast. Everyone is under pressure because time is so valuable, but we always prioritize prayer as most important.

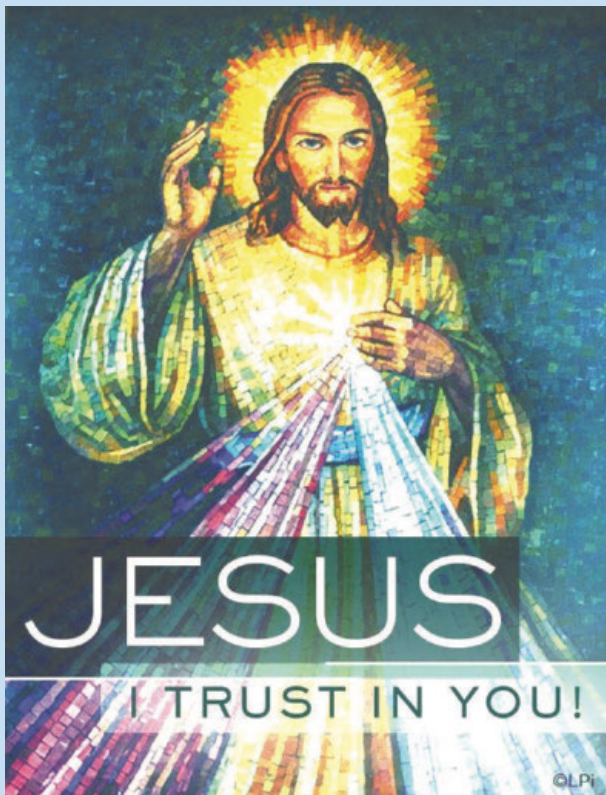
