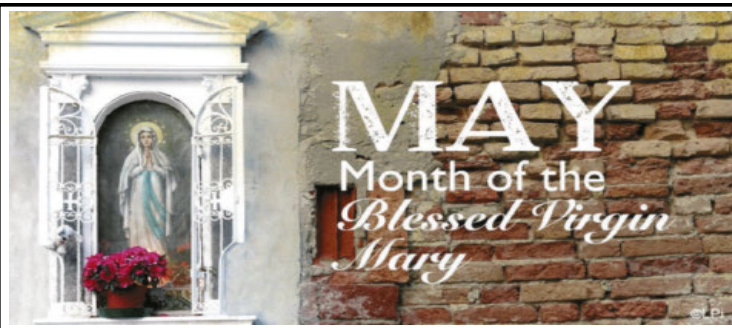

Fr. Joe's Jottings

Last weekend at the Masses in Pierre, Deacon Brad Palmer alluded to the Clergy Days that happens every year in October at Arrowhead Cedar Shores Resort in Oacoma, SD. All priests and deacons from the Diocese of Sioux Falls are invited to attend. The active priests are required, but the deacons and retired priests have the option to attend. The Diocese of Rapid City gathers at another time and sometimes I have attended parts of those days as well.

Before we began the Set Ablaze process many of us participated in an evaluation that identified some of our assets. The instrument was called Clifton Strengths. There are 34 categories, and this instrument helps one to know those categories which are their strongest and the weakest.

My top strength was harmony which means that I usually look for consensus. I look for practical or realistic solutions. "Why reinvent the wheel?" This question is combined with my second strength, analytical. I have found myself many times with an ability to think about many factors that affect a situation. Over the years these two strengths have helped me to complete goals and missions but also are not always accepted by others.

When Deacon Palmer referred to working together, I began to remember these two strengths. Over the years, God has blessed me with a desire that together we can find a solution and execute. We live in an imperfect world and there are 34 different strengths according to this instrument. It is hoped that Set Ablaze will bring out the strengths of everyone so we can pass on our Catholic Faith to the present and future generations.

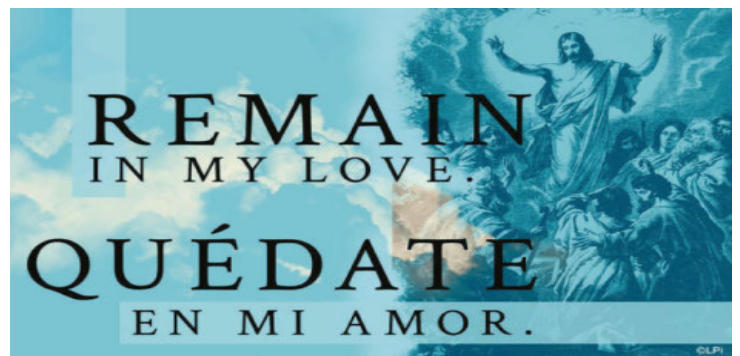

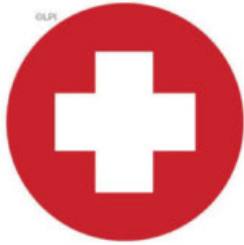

Fish – Worship – Socialize – Eat – Pray.

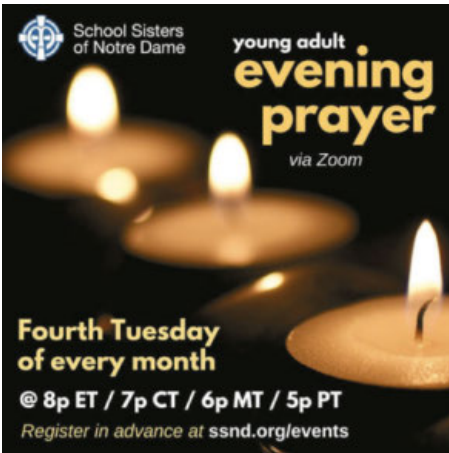
