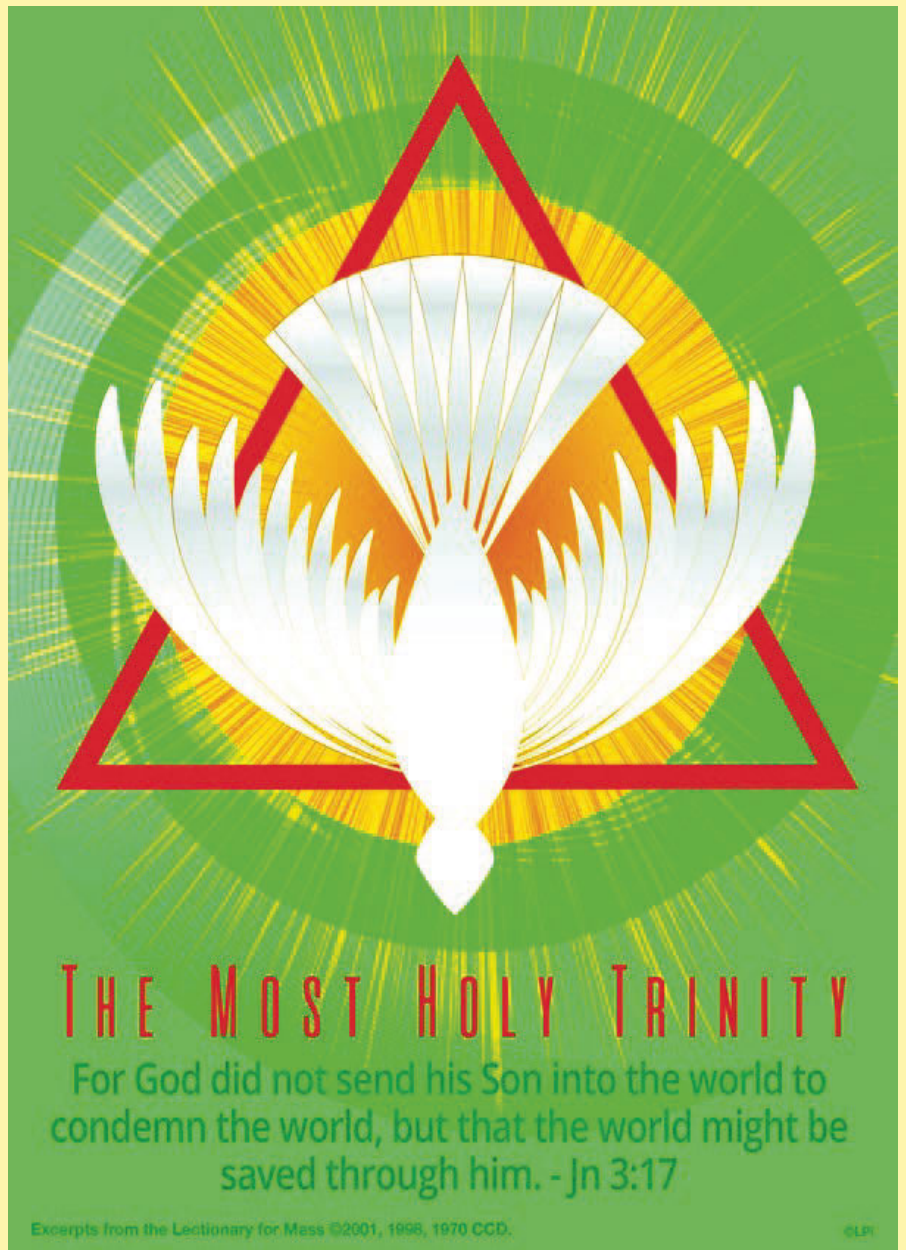

Most Holy Trinity Sunday May 26, 2024



Fr. Joe's Jottings

Several years ago, I was the pastor in Huron. We consolidated all the Catholic Parishes in Beadle County into one parish. The name selected was Holy Trinity. This weekend is the patronal feast day for that parish. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit working together as one God was the image those parishes followed. Now they are amid becoming a pastorate.

Soon it will be time for the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation for the candidates from Sacred Heart Parish and SS Peter and Paul Parish. Bishop Donald Kettler has agreed to be the celebrant for those of Potter County while Bishop Donald DeGroot has agreed to be the celebrant for those of Hughes County. At 5:00 pm on June 8th, Bishop Kettler will celebrate Mass with the people of St. Anthony and the Altar Society will be hosting a social afterwards. During this Mass, the students of Sacred Heart Parish will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and are invited to the social. This is a great example of parishes within a pastorate working together. The reality is that those two local school districts collaborate so well in many activities already, therefore we can build upon some existing relationships.

At 1:30 pm on June 9th, Bishop DeGroot will celebrate Mass with the people of SS Peter and Paul and be confirming the candidates from that parish. There will not be a social afterwards because as a pastorate, all will be preparing for the annual fishing charity event for the funding of seminarian education. SS Peter and Paul Parish and St. John the Evangelist, Ft. Pierre will be welcoming the seminarians from both the Diocese of Sioux Falls and the Diocese of Rapid City to evening prayer and social. This would be an example of parishes and dioceses working together.
